1. As regards rations on moves by sea I think that strictly speaking this could be dispensed with as troops will be fed on the ship. However Q (Movements) say that their advice is that 7 days rations should be carried on all long moves ~~by~~ rail or sea - to make the ~~rule~~^a rule of certainly simplifies things. I recommend that you adopt it - Any unconsumed rations carried on a ship would be taken over by the Steward.

As there is at present no such officer at ALGOT the travel order must be obtained from HQ Force 141 who require for this purpose a nominal roll (showing name, rank, and ~~any~~ ^{any} serial number). It is most strongly urged that you send a U.S. officer to ALGOT Liaison to deal with E.N. Force 141 over travel order.

3. Acting on your instructions ALGOT Liaison will make application for the move to the appropriate branch of HQ Force 141 - for air packages to 3(Mov & Tn) and for road, rail, and sea moves to 4(SD) by whom the application is forwarded to 2(Mov & Tn) A.F.H.Q.

4. Detailed Move Orders for all personnel (British and U.S.) are issued by 2(Mov & Tn) and will be received by ALGOT Liaison and forwarded to you. The point of departure selected by 2 (Mov & Tn) will presumably normally be ALGOT except in the case of rail moves when it should be possible to use ELIDA station. It is assumed that you will be responsible for arranging moves from CHUSA to ~~the~~ point of departure.

5. As there are no facilities here for accommodating or feeding any personnel it is most important that they should not come to HQ Force 141 and every effort will be made to supply you with the complete move order issued by 2 (Mov & Tn) before personnel leave CHUSA.
