MEMORANDUM FOR THE G.O.C.

As a result of a conversation with Group Captain Benson and Colonel Maxwell, G.O.C. 10 Corps and others, I have decided to continue a Civil Affairs Group at 8 Army, subject to any constraints which the G.O.C. 8 Army may have to make, consisting of Group Captain Benson, Major Bootle, Major Millard, one Finance Officer, one Legal Officer and one other officer (A or B), who will be responsible in 8 Army for such future operations as may arise under the direction of G.O.C. 8 Army after the completion of 1944 operation. The officers mentioned above will not take any part in the territorial administration of SUMATRA after the setting up of ARMY H.Q. in SUMATRA under G.O.C. 8 Army and D.C. 8 Army, which will occur in the course of the next fortnight. These officers will be free for future operations.

Group Captain Benson will be born on ARMY establishment as G.O.C., CAMBODIA, but the work of G.O.C. CAMBODIA, will be undertaken by Lieut. Colonel Lord Gerald Wainwright who will, for the purpose, be posted as G.O.C., SUMATRA PROVINCE. The other officers will be carried either on the H.Q. or the field establishment of ARMY but will be detached to Group Captain Benson for the purposes stated.

G.O.C. 10 Corps has asked for two Civil Affairs Officers with each of his two divisions undertaking operation SUMATRA. One British and one American officer will be detailed with each of these two divisions from among the officers now in SUMATRA who took part in the early stages of operation HENRY. The names of the officers selected will be notified in due course.

Since part of the planning of operation SUMATRA at H.Q. 10 Corps will be undertaken in SUMATRA, it will be desirable for two officers to be attached to H.Q. 10 Corps to act as liaison between H.Q. 10 Corps, Military Government Section A.P.S., ARMY, 15 Army Group and the Civil Affairs detachment at H.Q. 8 Army. The following officers have been provisionally detailed for this purpose:-

Lieut. Colonel R.H.J. Nichols (B)
Lieut. Colonel Montford (A) (as soon as he is released from duty in East Africa).

These two officers will take up their residence with H.Q. 10 Corps but will be travelling between 10 Corps and the other formations referred to for the purpose of planning the Civil Affairs administration in the territory occupied as a result of operation SUMATRA.

Group Captain Hanson will be home on ADJUT establishment as C.O., CAMBRIA, but the work of C.O., CAMBRIA, will be undertaken by Lieut. Colonel Lord Gerald Halloway who will, for the purpose, be posted as C.O., CAMBRIA, 15th Army Group. The other officers will be carried either on the H.Q. or the field establishment of ADJUT and will be detached to Group Captain Hanson for the purposes stated.

C.O., CAMBRIA, 10 Corps has asked for two Civil Affairs Officers with each of his two divisions undertaking operations in CAMBRIA. One British and one American Officer will be detailed with each of these two divisions from among the officers now in CAMBRIA who took part in the early stages of operation HENRY. The names of the officers selected will be notified in due course.

Since part of the planning of operation HENRY at H.Q., 10 Corps will be undertaken in CAMBRIA, it will be desirable for two officers to be attached to H.Q., 10 Corps to act as liaison between H.Q., 10 Corps, Military Government Section A.F.M.G., ADJUT, 15 Army Group and the Civil Affairs detachment at H.Q., 8 Army. The following officers have been provisionally detailed for this purpose:-

Lieut. Colonel H.H.J. Michels (B)
Lieut. Colonel Montford (A) (as soon as he is released from duty in Pantellaria).

These two officers will take up their residence with H.Q., 10 Corps but will be travelling between 10 Corps and the other formations referred to for the purpose of planning the Civil Affairs administration in the territory occupied as a result of operation HENRY.

YEO and CORBIN are in H.A.

4. MATHEW in the initial stages is attached to Road and Rail branch of 8th Army to act as their C.A. Staff officer.
I am also going to attach a Supply Officer to WEST. Possibly MATTHEWS at present on the road between CAIRO and SOUSE. ✓
5. Phase II, which consists of getting them away from here is laid on. I shall stay here with WILLIAMS until I get the reserves over and then go to HOBBSFIELD. ✓

Dear G.S.O.1,

Thank you for the copy of your most interesting D/O letter of 5 July 43, giving the activities of your branch. I hope that you will continue to send these to us and we will reciprocate directly. We are settled in a permanent home, but at the moment are moving from place to place, which is a very big undertaking with some 400 officers and over 1,000 O.Rs. Although it is extremely hard work, it is very interesting. I personally am handing over the post of C.S.O. ANGOT to my American opposite number, but I shall probably remain as a free lance on this H.Q. until we get settled and will endeavour to make it my duty to write you D/O letters from time to time, letting you know how we are getting on.

A number of D/O and private letters are still arriving in Middle East for Gen. Romell, myself and other officers. I have written and asked Mrs. Lloyd-Carson to collect these and put them in an envelope addressed to me and then forward them here through the official mail. I am taking the same action with letters that arrive here by error for officers in your Command.

Thank you very much for your offer of 25 officers from your pool. We are, as you can well imagine, desperate for staff here.

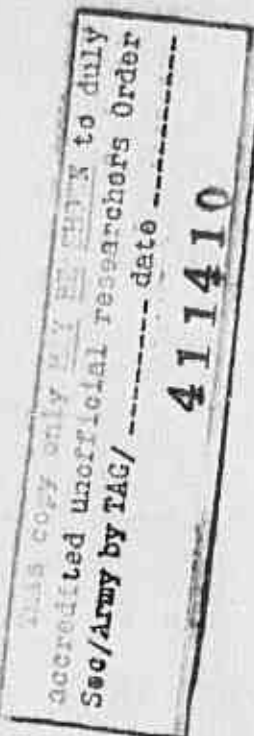

2. With further reference to your CEA/27 It is vital that I should have the exact numbers of the personnel who are at Sousse now and I have signalled to you and to Capt Ryger for these details. The same applies to vehicles, drivers and clerks and any other personnel. I can only move personnel from Sousse over to Sicily through Ferry Control here and before they will allot space they require to know the exact number of vehicles and personnel.

3. I am most likely going to move the reserve officers over from Sousse to Syracuse almost immediately and am only waiting until confirmation comes in of the capture of this city before going to Ferry Control to make the necessary arrangements. But until I can ascertain exact numbers I cannot make any move. The same remarks apply to transport and other ranks. 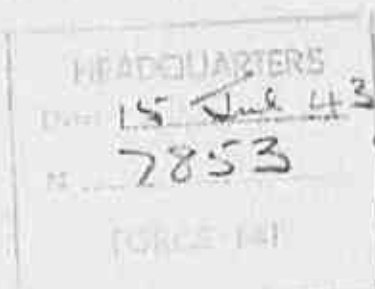
