MEMORANDUM BY PRINCIPAL ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS ON
APPROPRIATE OF DIVISIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND T/O W.E.

1. The position regarding the T/O W.E. is that as far as the British side is concerned the figures now shown on the approved W.E. are those submitted as at 30 Apr.

As far as the American side is concerned, the figures are as submitted to the War Department and subsequently approved by them by signal.

2. In the meantime, Col. Spofford and Col. Maxwell have discussed in detail with the heads of divisions, divisional and field requirements. In addition certain suggestions have been put forward from Washington or London. Both sets of modifications have been incorporated in the final plan which it is expected will be approved by the Commander-in-Chief about tomorrow.

3. The position therefore arises that there are discrepancies in the total, and even larger discrepancies in detail between the original posts contemplated as of 30 Apr, and this now forming part of the layout of the Division, which are now incorporated in the final plan.

4. A further difficulty relates to O.Rs since it has not been considered necessary to incorporate this in the annexes to the plan of divisional organisation.

5. It is therefore recommended:

- (a) That the Chief Staff Officer be charged with the immediate task of working out a revised T/O W.E. on the basis of the figures to the final plan as regards officers, and making suitable

(b) That a fleet should be added to establishment of various ranks which should only be filled with the approval and to the extent agreed by A.F.H.Q.

(c) That as soon as these calculations are complete, the necessary steps are taken to get approval from the British and American sides for the new W/O W.E.

(d) Parallel to this work, the officer charged with responsibility for supply should be working out the detailed G.1093 and 2/3.

(e) That no further alterations to HQ or field or divisional organisations be accepted until further notice.

Planning discussions with Force 343 Staff suggests advisability adding to Civilian Supply Division following officers to serve in industries and resources section:

(A) 1 American Officer experience electric utility engineering to survey utility installations and plan rehabilitation and supply.
