1. Before leaving C.C.A.O. instructed me to see General Penny regarding ANGOT War Establishment for Signals, etc. in Sicily. I saw General Penny and he said that he would consider this and let me have his reply. Before doing so, he left for the island. I have seen G.3.O.1. here and understand from him that General Penny is considering this matter in Sicily, and after looking around there will be in a position to give us a definite answer. In the meantime two British officers are being obtained by Signals for us and are being sent over to the island to carry out preliminary investigation and report. I cannot, therefore, do anything further at this end.

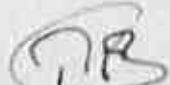

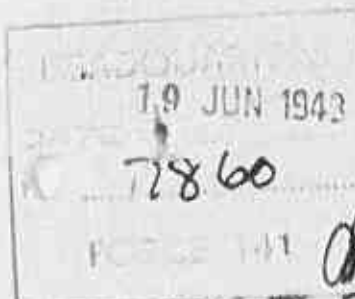
