Reference your minute 3 June, the answers to the points raised are as follows.

A. Officers

You should circulate C.S.O. and Heads of Divisions asking them to return to you the total number of British officers with rank. You will not mention the 10% extra which will be added subsequently by you after consultation with Col. Spofford and myself.

B. Clerks

You will not ask the C.S.O. and Divisions for these figures in the first instance but work on the establishment as at 30 April, increased pro rata to the increase between the 30 April establishment and the Annexes to the final plan.
