Italy - I know so well - I gave several  
Broadcasts at the B.B.C some time ago.

PREPARATION FOR PRESS VISIT MONDAY, 5th JULY 1943

1. Members of the Allied press will visit Chrea on Monday, the 5th of July 1943. The party will consist of about 20 press correspondents and will leave AFHQ at approximately 0900 hours. The party will arrive at Headquarters AEFOT Chrea at approximately 1100 hours. General Matherly, D.C.C.A.C., will receive the correspondents and show them over the Headquarters and the Hotel Allemand. They will then walk through the camp accompanied by the D.C.C.A.C. and Lt. Col. Aitken to the Instruction School, arriving at approximately 1130 hours. The press correspondents will see a class being conducted by Major Howell. The correspondents will lunch at "A" Mess at 1300 hours. Captain Pearson will be responsible for arranging this with the C.S.C.

2. At 1400 hours General Matherly will see the press correspondents at Miami and the following officers will be present.

3. Lt. Col. Jordan will see that the students in the old class who are not attending the lecture are not in their quarters from 1100 hours to 1300 hours.

SCHEDULE FOR PRESS VISIT MONDAY, July 5, 1943

- 09:00 : Press leaves PRO AFHQ, after which Major Morley Fletcher will phone Chrea HQ the number of people coming for lunch.
- 11:00 : Arrive HQ, Chrea. General Mc Sherry will receive correspondents and show them the Allemand plant. Then a walk through camp to school.
- 11:30 : Correspondents will visit school, with Major Rowell conducting a class. Major Rowell is informed and will lay it on, Lt. James is setting up some picture possibilities for photographers at the school.
- 13:00 : Lunch, after which General Mc Sherry will speak and invite questions.
- 15:00 : Press returns to Algiers.

Note: Though 11:30 to 13:00 hours seems a long time for no pre-lunch event, I believe we probably will be a few minutes late all along the way and that correspondents will ask questions about the school, after watching the class. Therefore the time would be too short for General Mc Sherry's talk and the questions, before lunch.
