CIVIL AFFAIRS INSTRUCTIONS NO. 3.I. CIVILIAN AIR RAID DEFENSE.

Auth: CG IAC REINF
Initial: WSC
Date: 28 June 1943

The Civil Affairs officer is primarily responsible for supervising passive air raid protective measures in civil installations, except those guarded by troops, and the maintenance, re-organization and supervision of the civilian warning system, including civilian report and control organization, fire prevention and fighting system, wardens, salvage organization, air raid shelters, casualty reporting system, rest centers, emergency feeding, system for billeting or evacuation of homeless and information and instructions to public. C.A.O. should, to the extent practical, use existing systems and existing local governmental and civilian personnel.

As soon as practicable, C.A.O. should make surveys of existing systems and determine additional materials and equipment needed. These surveys will be coordinated with Engineers, G-4, Anti-Aircraft and Air Support Command. Copies of surveys should be sent to Commanding General, Force 343 (Civil Affairs Section).

Force 141 (AIGOT) has ordered supply of certain civilian fire-fighting equipment and request should be made to this headquarters.

After completion of the surveys C.A.O. should re-organize the systems to extent found necessary and should see that they operate efficiently under his supervision.

After Air Support Command has established air raid warning system and advised Civil Affairs Section, C.A.O. should see that widespread publicity on the warning system is given in community.

To insure co-operation from reporting services, it will be advisable to arrange that all calls for civilian rescue and casualty services are made on warden's reports to a control center, such center to be operated by local authorities under general supervision of C.A.O.

II. SUSPECTED PERSONS.

In addition to prisoners of war and civilian internees (Party leaders or other civilians known to be dangerous) there may be persons suspected whose character it may be difficult to establish promptly. Such may, without being formally interned, be held under Sec. 2, Article VII of Proclamation No. 2, pending further investigation. Such a course may be preferable to formal internment. The person so held may be readily released if the accusation is baseless whereas procedure for release of civilian internee is more complicated and will be particularly difficult if internee has been removed elsewhere.

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Provincial or Communal budgetary items. C.A.O's will, until further instructions, keep their own accounts of such expenditure and will obtain the necessary funds from a Civil Affairs Finance Officer. Arrangements have been made for each C.A. Finance Officer to draw funds from the nearest Army Disbursing Officer against receipt and a written request which must include the words "to be used in the administration of ANGOT and/or the handling of any problems arising in connection with the Military Government in MORRIS". The C.A. Finance Officer will not have to account for such funds to the Army Disbursing Officer, but will, through Civil Affairs Section, Force 343, account to ANGOT. Up to approximately D plus 10 C.A. Finance Officers will receive yellow seal dollars after which it is likely that they will be given Allied Military currency by the Disbursing Officers. Every request by a C.A. Finance Officer to a Disbursing Officer for funds must be countersigned by the Senior Officer of the Civil Affairs Section of the Sub-Task Force.

IX. PAYMENTS TO INFORMERS.

The authority of the Senior Civil Affairs Officer, Force 343, must be obtained before any funds are utilized for payments to informers.

Industry: There are no large undertakings; the following are reported (there is no information about size or location); Cement manufacturers - 2 firms (presumably natural cement from local raw material); Flour mills - 4 firms; Furniture makers - 3 firms; Joiners and cabinet makers - 10 firms; Mechanical workshops - 1 firm; Olive oil producers - 9 firms; Rope and string manufacturers - 4 firms; Saw mills - 1 firm; Smiths - 8 firms; Wine producers - 10 firms. Cereals, vegetables, and fruit (including grapes, citrus fruits, and olives) are grown; livestock are kept, and cheese is made. District sparsely settled.

The Marchese Salvatore Jacone della Motta generally lives on his estate at MAREM. He is an old Sicilian landowner, b. 1902, who had several properties taken from him by the Fascist Government; he is very pro-British and despises the Fascist officials as opportunists; closely associated with the British community in the island; is a Catholic of very high principles; unmarried. Gravini is the leading landlord.

Schools: Liceo-Ginnasio and Technical School, east of Piazza Umberto I with museum and public library in building, Convitto dei Salesiani, large building at highest point in town, former university, now home and school for war orphans. Technical Institute, School of Agriculture, School of Ceramics, Episcopal School - Locations unknown.
