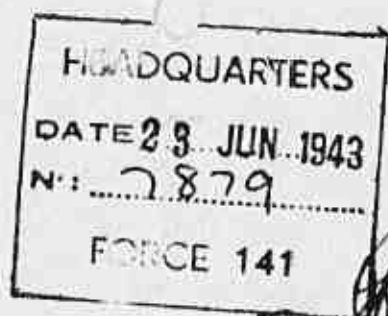

2. (a) It is considered that all forces and headquarters intimately involved in the operation should use the same time system in order to prevent any chance of errors or misunderstandings occurring. If this principle is accepted, the system laid down must be selected so as to cause the minimum inconvenience to those areas which must change their systems.

(b) It is desirable, also, that the time system chosen should be the local time in the area of operations on the score of convenience, which is considered to be an important factor affecting, particularly, larger headquarters.

3. (a) It is recommended, therefore, that "B" time should be used by forces engaged in Operation "HUSKY" (A.F.H.Q. and H.Qs. Forces 141, 143 and 145), as its adoption would most nearly satisfy the conditions laid down in para. 2 above.
