MEMORANDUM FOR: Lt. Colonel Charles Fairman, Military Government
Section, AFHQ

1. Reference your memorandum of 28 July 43 concerning AMGOT "bibles" regret we have no available copies to send back at the present time. We are instructed to provide each officer leaving for Sicily with a copy but have not had a sufficient number to distribute to all of them. We are now in the process of moving and therefore mimeographing additional copies is impracticable. Aside from this, however, there have been several amendments to the original "bible" and there will be other amendments. Therefore we are waiting until such time as they are completed before issuing and distributing the "new bible".

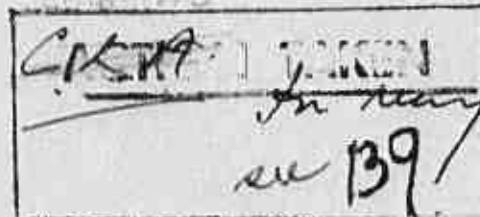

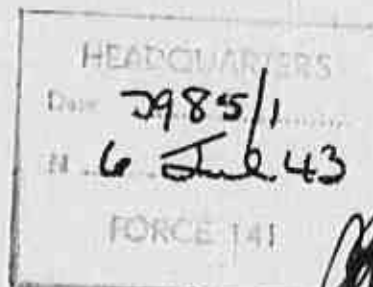
