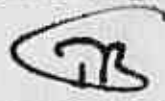

- (a) GOBLET
- (b) MUSKET
- (c) BUTTRESS
- (d) MUSTANG
- (e) GANGWAY

2. Para 3 (a) of Planning Security Instructions for Operations GOBLET and BUTTRESS, 141P/1400/G(Ib) of 20 Jun 43 (issued to branches and sections of this H.Q. only), will be amended accordingly.

3. (a) BIGOT is defined as a code-word placed beside the security classification on secret documents and messages to indicate that they should be handled by and distributed to a limited number of specially designated personnel.

- (b) The decision to use the code-word BIGOT on a document concerning these operations or to incorporate BIGOT in the text of a message must rest with the originator of the document or message and should be governed by the following considerations:

(1) Unnecessary use of BIGOT will tend to debase its security value and will overload high-grade signal traffic.

(2) Generally speaking BIGOT should be used only when mention is made of any of the following items:

- (a) The code-word of the Operation itself. In many cases inclusion of this should not be necessary.
- (b) The main objective and subsidiary targets.
- (c) Pertinent dates.

(c) The handling of papers marked BICOT will be carried out as follows

(1) All papers marked BICOT will bear this word in red in block letters in the top right hand corner.

(2) When such papers are transferred between Headquarters, or within a headquarters by personnel other than responsible officers or confidential clerks of the originating section or branch, double envelopes will be used, the outer envelope bearing no classification or code-word. The inner envelope will be marked with the classification and the code-word

BIGOT, the letter in red block letters on both front and back. Both envelopes should be addressed to the holder of an appointment or a named person.

(3) The inner envelope will be opened only by the addressee personally or another person expressly authorized by him.

(d) On all documents and messages marked BIGOT the code-word of the Operation referred to in the message will also be added. Where a number of operations are referred to the name of only the latest and therefore the most secret need be added. This applies equally to the inner envelope

(e) Where there is more than one copy of a BIGOT document, copies will be numbered serially and the distribution shown on each. Receipts will indicate the numbers received.

(f) In the case of BIGOT messages, the words MOST SECRET BIGOT followed by the code word of the Operation will be placed at the beginning of the text.

Several Post-HUSKY operations are being planned by various Staffs and Headquarters. It has become apparent that these plans are becoming too widely known and discussed in this Headquarters. It is essential that knowledge thereof should be strictly confined to those who definitely require such knowledge in the performance of their duties.

For the time being, it should not be necessary at this Headquarters for such knowledge to extend beyond the heads of certain Branches and Sections. These should, if possible, deal personally with any matters affecting such operations: if they require the assistance of other members of their staff, it is their responsibility to ensure that the number of these is confined to the minimum, and that proper arrangements are made within their branch for the restricted handling and custody of all papers concerning the operations in question. 475

It has been arranged that incoming messages containing reference to the code names of any of these operations will be addressed by S.M.C. (Staff Message Control) only to the head of the 'Action Section' personally; it will then be the latter's responsibility to decide whether any further distribution is necessary, and to advise S.M.C. accordingly: no copy of such messages will be provided for the War Room. See 26
