COMMAND AND ADMINISTRATION OF SICILY

- 1. GENERAL. a. In accordance with policy for the organization and military administration of ITALY contained in Administrative Memorandum Number 63, this headquarters, cs, No. 1 District has been established to provide for the command and administrative control of SICILY as part of the British L of C (Communications Zone).
- b. It is intended that the whole of SICILY, including the AGADEAN Islands, shall eventually come under the control of No. 1 District. While, U.S. field formations, U.S. supplies and base depots remain on the island, there will be an interim period in which the island will be divided for administrative purposes into:.
 - (1) No. 1 District controlling the former 8th Army area.
 - (2) Island Base Section controlling the 7th Army area.
- As U.S. field formations are withdrawn from SICILY the area controlled by the Island Base Section will reduced to an area around PALERMO in which U.S. stores and depots will be located until the base section is closed.
- c. The boundary between No. 1 District and Island Base Section area will be defined by this headquarters based on recommendation of the General Officer Commanding, No. 1 District in consultation with the Commanding General, Seventh Army and the Commanding Officer, Island Base Section. Subsequent changes in the boundary will be similarly defined as they become necessary. The General Officer Commanding, No. 1 District will be responsible for defining boundaries of Base Areas within No. 1 District, and will report them to this headquarters.
- 2. COMMAND. a. No. 1 District will be directly under command of this headquarters.
- b. Island Base Section will remain under command of Commanding General, Communications Zone.
- c. Headquarters, Seventh Army and Headquarters, 30 Corps, and all troops assigned to these formations will be under the command of this headquarters for all purposes except administration as defined in par. 3, below.

 - 3. ADMINISTRATION. a. No. 1 District will be responsible for:

1. Higher authority has designated a new boundary between Seventh Army and Eighth Army, dividing the island of SICILY into areas for administration, regrouping, and security.

2. Seventh Army will move to the area west of the new boundary. For boundary between Armies, and boundary between II Corps and Provisional Corps, see Annex 1 (marked map).

3. For revised list of troops attached to II Corps and Provisional Corps, see Annex 2.

4. Responsibility for the movement of units attached to II Corps and Provisional Corps, as indicated in Annex 2, rests with the corps concerned. In addition, Corps concerned will be responsible for the movement of units listed in Annex 3. Priority of westward movement on the north coast Toad (Route 113) is in the order 45th Infantry Division, 3rd Ranger Battalion, 3rd Infantry Division, 13th FA Brigade, 9th Infantry Division.

5. The 1st, 3rd, and 4th Ranger Battalions will be moved to a concentration area in vicinity of CORLEONE, and will be assembled under the command of Lt. Col. W. H. DARBY, with instructions to prepare for early movement from this theatre.

6. Within Corps areas of responsibility as indicated in Annex 1, II Corps and Provisional Corps are responsible for the security of:

a. All Corps and subordinate unit installations.

D. All routes of supply, evacuation, and communication.

c. Such additional army installations as may be designated.

7. The Corps Commanders will be responsible for the police, discipline, and military courtesy of all military personnel within their areas.

15 Army Group wish the 8th Army area in Sicily after operations in the Island are finished to be as small as possible, but the area must include the PONTE OLTVO group of airfields and MILAZZO. It is considered that the boundary should run along the administrative Provincial boundaries as far as is possible.

- 2. It appears therefore that if the Provincial boundaries are to be followed the Western boundary of the 8th Army area should be the western boundary of the following Provinces: MESSINA, MNNA and CALTANISSITTA in order to include the PONTE OHIVO Airfields. This gives 8th Army more than half the island. I would suggest that the boundary cannot follow the Provincial boundaries but must be a line from (say) Cape Orlando down the West boundary of Catamia Province to the point where it joins the CALTANISSETTA Province's West boundary, down that boundary and thence S.W. to the coast in a line to include the PONTE CLIVO Airfields.
- 3. Would you clease let me have your views very urgently in order that I may put them up to 15 Army Group.
