In a letter of 17th September addressed to me, Lieut-Colonel Bernstein raises, inter alia, the following points:-

- (a) He wishes to season the Finance teams for Region 4, 5 and 6 with people who have had A.M.G. experience in Sicily; and suggests that 2 Majors and 2 Lieutenants designated to Region 7 should be transferred to Sicily in exchange for 4 experienced Finance men, who could go to Region 4, 6 and 5 in that order.
- (b) He asks how I would like to see the A.M.F.A. situation handled in Regions 4, 5 and 6.
- (c) He ^{asks} states "In view of the current planning for Regions 4, 5 and 6, do you think any additional amounts of A.M. Lire should be ordered".

In view of the fact that AMGOT H.Q. is at present allotted only Regions 1, 2 and 3 and as any questions asked on AMGOT's future relations with other Regions have been considered "ultra-vires" by M.G.S., I should like to receive some direction as to how the questions raised by Lieut-Colonel Bernstein should be answered.

I would propose to reply to the suggestion re staff that we would gladly accept the four officers in Sicily where we would give them training to fit them for their duties in Regions 4, 5 and 6. The dilution of Region I personnel to cover 2 Regions and a Headquarters will leave such a weak and understaffed team that we cannot yet consider parting with four experienced Finance men.

As regards the provision of A.M.F.A. personnel and the ordering of Allied Military Lire for Regions 4, 5 and 6, it is quite impossible to provide the former from here, or to estimate the latter. My suggestion would be to instruct Col. Bernstein to take what steps appear necessary to him, informing us accordingly.

The crux of the matter is that if AMGOT ^{are} is to handle these other Regions they must be so informed immediately; and must accordingly

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The crux of the matter is that if AMGOT ^{are} is to handle these other Regions they must be so informed immediately; and must accordingly be permitted to control the staff movements for these Regions as they think best. In the case of the Financial Division this would entail the early transfer to Sicily of personnel from Tizzi Ouzou.
