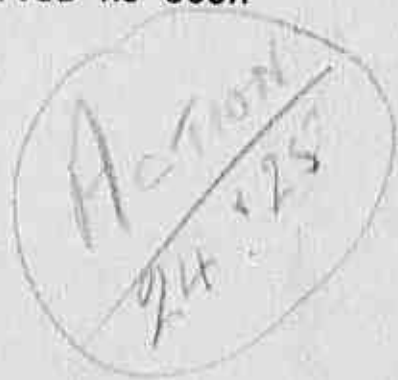

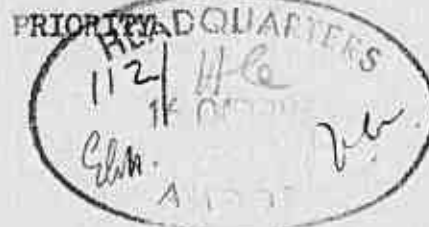

1. Region 4 personnel now moving as follows:

A) Party A, ^{see 22} 6 Officers, 19 EM/ORS, 18 vehicles, and 2 MCS moving to Taranto for AMGOT 8th Army at Bona on 13th of October, delayed a few days ETA Taranto 19 October.

B) Party B, 27 Officers left 7 October for Taranto via Bizerte and ferry service for AMGOT 8th Army ETA 16 October.

C) Party C, 6 Officers, 40 EM/ORS will embark Algiers 17 October for Taranto for AMGOT 8th Army ETA 22 October.

D) Party D, Total of 55 Officers, 75 EM/ORS, 26 vehicles, 4 MCS, Subdivided into Main Party of 40 Officers, 51 EM/ORS and all vehicles embarked Algiers for Naples for AMGOT 5th Army on the 13th of October ETA 19th October. Subsidiary parts, 15 Officers 24 EM/ORS left by train for Oran and thence for Naples the 13th of October ETA 21 October.

E) Brigadier Carr Commander of Region #4 leaves by Air the 16th of October for Naples, it is not known whether direct or with intermediate stops ETA 16 October.

F) 2nd Echelon Region #4 consisting of remainder to ~~the~~ strength with balance full allocation vehicles and TE/C 1098 equipment will move Naples soonest possible, details later.

G) All parties are carrying rations calculated leave 1 day in land on arrival.

2. Advance party AC 30 Officers, 10 EM/ORS and advance party of HQ displaced persons subcommission 5 Officers, 10 EM/ORS with 5 Officers of the American Red Cross, the whole moving in 1 party, left by train for Bizerte and thence for Palermo 14 October, ETA 20 October. All personnel carrying rations as in paragraph 1-G.

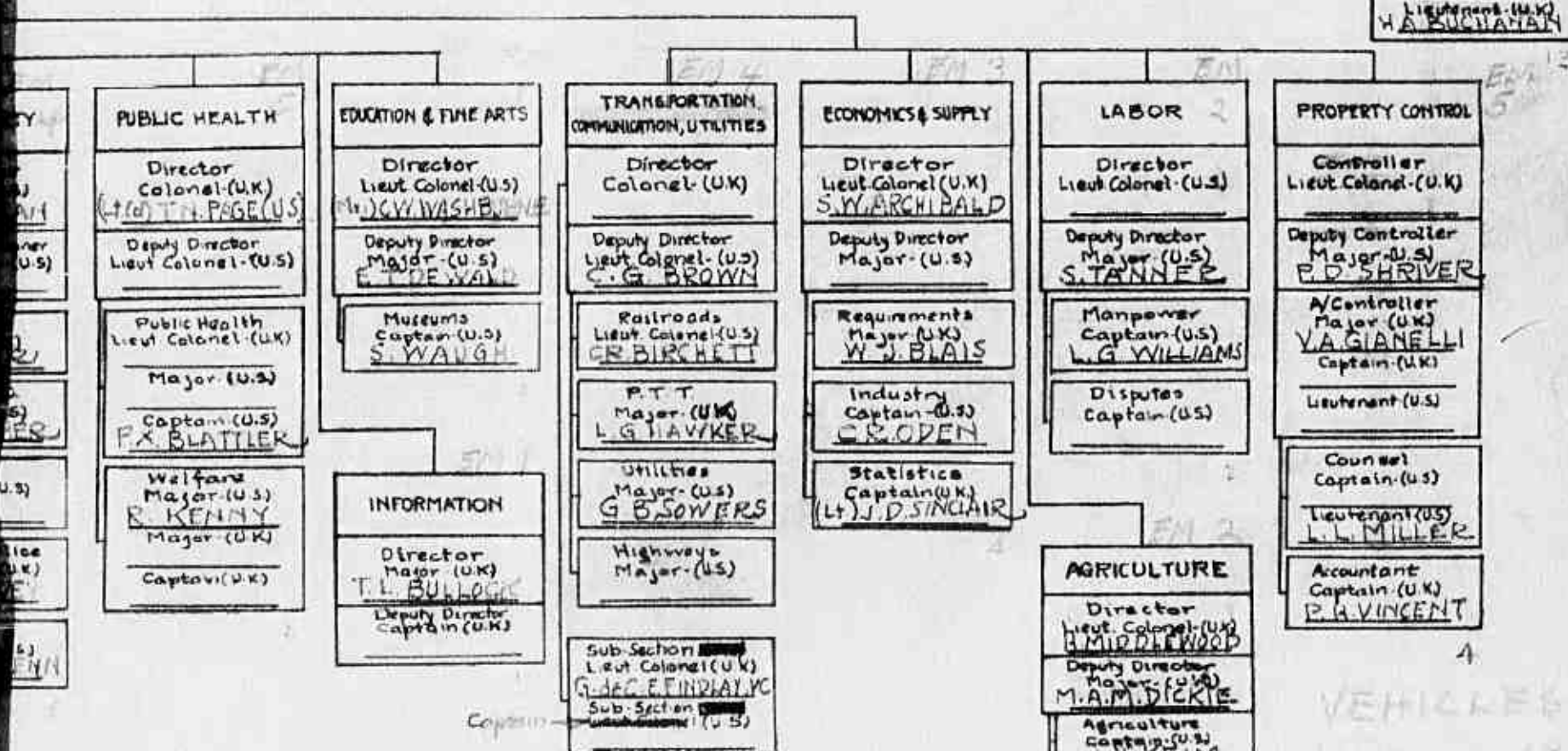

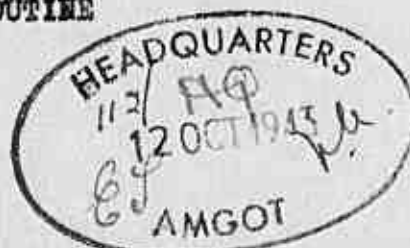

(d) Region IV staff officers now here are to remain in Region I until sent forward in a week or ten days.

II - VEHICLES:

(c) The balance of personnel (116 officers authorized - 41 actual) are to be moved to Naples on or about 10 October. This HQ is to get wire from General Clark calling this detachment forward.

(d) Region IV staff officers now here are to remain in Region I until sent forward in a week or ten days.

II - VEHICLES:

(a) AFHQ is to procure vehicles not already drawn. If they are drawn from 7th Army, this HQ will be immediately advised and transport will be arranged from here. If vehicles are drawn here, we will try to obtain drivers from 15 Army Group or elsewhere.

III - MISCELLANEOUS:

(a) We will try to get some typewriters out of the pool at Siracusa.

(b) Brigadier Carr is to send us a nominal roll of all personnel, including those assigned to East and West parties and main body. Brigadier Carr is to have entire personnel assigned to MAGOT so that proper parties can be attached to tactical units.

(c) Brigadier Carr will send copies of assignment by territory to Benson and Hume for their information and guidance.

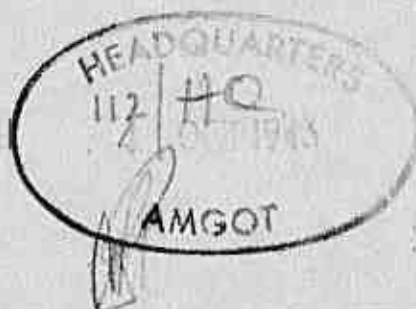

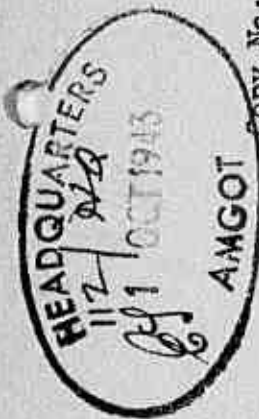

Rear party, including all O.R./E.N., (less a limited number who may be required for duty in Sicily), Stores, vehicles, etc., will, as far as can now be foreseen, be moved directly from North Africa to Italy when the situation permits.

REGION 4. MOVE TO SICILY

1. AMG Region 4 will move to Sicily in two or more echelons as follows:
2. In the first instance, officer personnel only will proceed, and the first wave will consist of officers of special divisions and S.C.A.C.s and senior U.A.F.C.s.
3. About 13 to 15 will proceed by air as soon as possible, i.e., about the beginning of October. Movement to be arranged by AFHQ. Weight of kit to be taken will be that allowed on permanent change of station. Officers' party proceeding by air will take with them a list of officers available to proceed to Sicily and the posts to which they have been assigned.
4. Remainder will move by sea as and when available. Rear party including all EM and ORs vehicles and stores will move from North Africa at a date to be notified later.
5. AMG Sicily will provide accommodation and messing.
6. No forms or proclamations, arm bands, etc., will be taken. These will proceed with rear party. All officers will take AMG bible and any other papers especially issued.
7. All British officers will be taken on the strength of Region 4 before proceeding to Sicily. American officers will be posted to new regiment if activated in time. British officers will be posted in any case to R.M. Region 4 before movement.
8. A net requisition by AFHQ for enlisted men will be made towards meeting deficiencies in Region 4. Brigadier Carr will supply lists of deficiencies to JACS by ranks and grades including ability to speak Italian.
