1. A detachment (Party D) consisting of 55 officers, 75 EM/OR, with 30 vehicles, will move between 11 Oct and 13 Oct 43.
2. (a) the following items deal only with vehicles, drivers, baggage and stores.
(b) an additional order will be issued to personnel other than drivers, when information becomes available.
(c) officers will inspect the urgent bulletin boards as ordered in warning order for Party D.

METHOD.

3. (a) A convoy of 30 vehicles will leave Tizi-Ouzou at 0935 hrs 11 Oct 43, with baggage and stores as detailed below:
(b) The Commander of the vehicles detailed, as far as Port of Embarkation, will be Capt. Secker. At Port of Embarkation Capt Secker will hand over to Lieut. Pelvo, who will accompany the convoy overseas in accordance with verbal orders.
(c) Colonel Gevers will act as OC Party D.
(d) Forming up

(i) the convoy will form in Tizi-Ouzou main street facing west with head of column at Standard filling station below Church.

(ii) Starting point - Standard filling station.

HEADQUARTERS REGION 4 - ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT.

FIELD.

OPERATION ORDER NO: 1.

27 Sep 43.

1.

The move of Region 4 from North Africa to Italy will take place via Sicily so far as officers (less those detailed for rear party) are concerned. Rear party, including all O.R./E.M., (less a limited number who may be required for duty in Sicily), Stores, vehicles, etc., will, as far as can now be foreseen, be moved directly from North Africa to Italy when the situation permits.

2. (a)

The first party to move to Sicily will proceed by air commencing early October and will number from ten to fifteen officers. It will consist of selected Heads of Special Divisions and S.C.A.Os, or senior C.A.P.Os. Officers concerned will be notified separately. Movement by air is being arranged by AFHQ. Application will be made for weight of baggage to be that allowed on permanent change of station.

(b)

Remaining officers (less rear party assignments) will proceed by sea at intervals during October. Strength of Groups will depend upon shipping space available and so far as possible Groups will consist of officers assigned to one or two provinces.

(c)

Rear party, as detailed separately, will move by sea to Italy at a date to be notified later.

3. (a)

Officers (and O.R./E.M., if applicable) in Sicily, will be attached to H.Q. A.M.G. Sicily, for rations and accommodation.

(b)

G.I. Region 4, will ensure that all British officers, (and O.Rs if applicable) proceeding to Sicily, have been posted to Region 4 before departure.

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2. (a) The first party to move to Sicily will proceed by air commencing early October and will number from ten to fifteen officers. It will consist of selected Heads of Special Divisions and S.C.A.Os, or senior C.A.P.Os. Officers concerned will be notified separately. Movement by air is being arranged by AFHQ. Application will be made for weight of baggage to be that allowed on permanent change of station.
- (b) Remaining officers (less rear party assignments) will proceed by sea at intervals during October. Strength of groups will depend upon shipping space available and so far as possible groups will consist of officers assigned to one or more provinces.
- (c) Rear party, as detailed separately, will move by sea to Italy at a date to be notified later.
3. (a) Officers (and C.R./E.M. if applicable) in Sicily, will be attached to H.Q. A.A.G. Sicily, for rations and accommodation.
- (b) G.I. Region 4, will ensure that all British officers, (and O.Rs if applicable), proceeding to Sicily, have been posted to Region 4 before departure.
- (c) Spare kits, within prescribed allowances, and not accompanying officers upon departure, will be delivered to H.Q. Commandant, Region 4, for safe custody and for forwarding with a party proceeding by sea or, if ordered, for transportation with baggage of rear party.
- (d) All baggage will be clearly marked to show name, rank, serial number and A.A.G. 4.
- (e) No Region forms or publications will be taken, but all officers will be in possession of AGOT Bible, and such supplemental documents as may be issued by Region Headquarters.
4. Postal addresses and LPOs will be announced when assigned.
