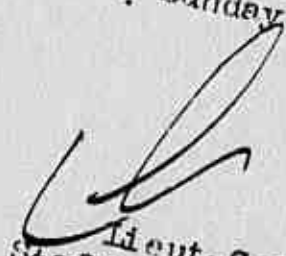

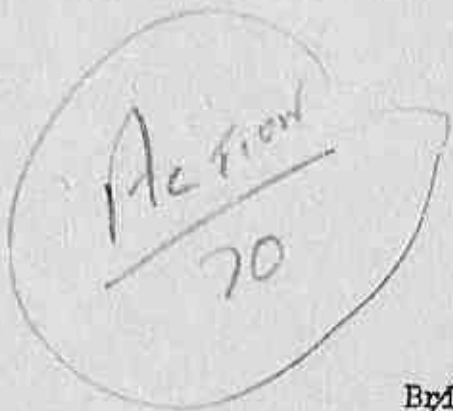

Reference recent conversation Lt. Col. French - Major Pearey.

1. The present strength of British personnel stationed in the American half of the island is 15 officers and 300 men all of whom are deprived of certain postal and MAPI facilities which are not provided from American sources.

2. The supplies which are required are listed below in order of importance:

- (a) Air Mail Letter Cards
- (b) 3d Stamps
- (c) Airmail Postage
- (d) Whisky
- (e) Free Issue of Cigarettes, Chocolate and Matches.

3. Can you please arrange to draw these supplies regularly for the personnel specified in paragraph 1 above and advise this H.Q. when the supplies are available at your H.Q. for collection from here.

4. It is suggested that with each consignment of stores you include a bill for these items you have purchased so as to enable the Camp Commandant to arrange repayment.

My Dear General

I have just received your telegram about your kit, but the personal telegram of July 20 has not arrived. If I hear nothing, I shall leave here by air for Malta on Saturday 24th. I am already a week overdue, as I could have left on the 17th, had not C.C.A.O. here, insisted on my staying ~~here~~ until the War Office approved the W.E. for the 55 officers I had obtained from the School. There is no further news from the War Office nor any instructions about their despatch, and I feel I must not delay any longer. I have been longing to get to Con Benson, and be up in front with him. It will all be over soon.

The 25 officers are a good lot, about half speak Italian, and 12 are lieutenants. To make up the number I got Major Young and Captain Harris, both excellent people.

C.C.A.O. is offering Legal Staff from the territories and I bring a list with me. I cannot get financial staff, except the offer of 2 Sergeants, who would have to be commissioned.

I think someone will have to deal with shipping and supplies here for Seitz, as there will be muddles. There is one already about some 500 tons of non-existent supplies !!

I shall have your baggage well cared for by one of the 25 officers proceeding by fast road convoy to Sousse. I have provisionally arranged for their despatch and equipment, as no instructions have been received, and pending War Office approval of the W.E. 1752

Memorandum for: S.C.A.O. - Siracusa, Ragusa

1. As a result of talks the S.C.A.O. had with AMSOE officers on his recent trip through provinces of Ragusa and Siracusa, it is suggested that personnel might be economized by concentrating officers who are now stationed in smaller towns in the adjacent larger towns where, say three or four, such officers can operate as a team.
