I was posted to A.M.G.O.T. from the Malta Command on 22 Jul 43 and, as my family in Malta is dependent on my Army pay, I would be grateful if this matter were treated as most urgent and that the most practical arrangements for forwarding an allotment to Malta were immediately effected.
2. On my arrival in Sicily at the end of July last I saw No. 8 Command Paymaster, C.M.F. He was not however in a position to inform me as to whether it were possible to have the Malta Command Paymaster to pay my pay and allowances by cheque direct into my Bank a/c at Barclay's (D.C. & O.), Vallette, Malta. They instructed me to have an account opened at Barclay's Bank, King William Street, London, branch for the purpose of transferring money to my Bank a/c in Malta. It now transpires that this branch was not the correct one, vide attached letter from Barclay's Bank, Malta. I am not now aware whether you have paid any money into any Bank a/c of mine much less whether an allotment was transferred to my family in Malta.
3. A.M.G.O.T. H.Q. has undertaken to make arrangements for me to have all my pay and allowances paid direct to my a/c in Barclay's Bank, Malta, in that they consider it possible for you to effect such payments through the Malta Command Paymaster. I take leave to intimate a pecuniary Claim in respect of loss of luggage due to the exigencies of the Service. On Thursday 9th Sept. 43, a road convoy was proceeding from Tizzi-Ouzou (Allied School for Mil. Govt.) to Bizerta. About noon on that day a truck loaded with Officers' Kits overturned at a point of the road where there was a narrow bridge over a precipice. The truck went hurtling over the bridge and there were fatal Casualties.

My baggage, consisting of a large suit-case was part of the load on this truck and it was not recovered after the accident. It is believed that it was smashed or destroyed in the crash. Search was made at the time without results.

The contents of the suit-case included much of my Military Kit and the value of my claim (moderately estimated) is L.80.

As it has been found impossible to obtain the appropriate Army Claim Form in this Theatre of War a

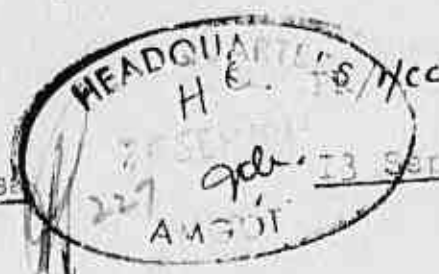

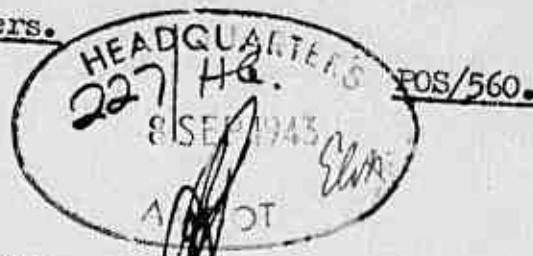
