TO : Chief Staff Officer AMG. Headquarters.

1. With reference letter addressed to Senior Civil Affairs Officer Agrigento Ref. 241/Hq. dated 11 Nov. 1943.

2. Hotel Albergo dei Templi Agrigento has been taken into custody by Assistant Controller of Property Agrigento. Senior Civil Affairs Officer Agrigento has dismissed the manager Sig. Alphonse Attanasio for dishonesty.

3. The hotel has been requisitioned by Armed Forces and is at present occupied by 52nd Troop Carrying Wing U.S. Air Corps. Full inventories have been prepared and although a small amount of furniture was lost in the early stages of the occupation most has been preserved. The property has not been damaged and is in excellent condition.

4. Assistant Controller of Property Agrigento will ensure that occupying units duly account for all breakages etc and when the Armed Forces eventually vacate Assistant Controller of Property will take over personal control of the Property.

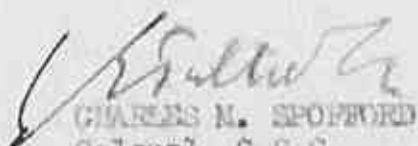
