

- On 13th August, 1943 I was assigned C.AO. in Sciecca District which embraces the communes of Sciecca, Menfi, Santa Margherita, Sambuca and Montevago. Prior to that date the C.A.O. was Major Ashworth who is now Provincial C.A.P.O. Agrigento.
- 2. On 14th August, 1943, Santa Margherita was visited by Major Ashworth and myself and he introduced me to the Mayor and Marshall of Carabiniere, also to a Lieutenant of the American Army whose name I cannot recall. Major Ashworth had visited Santa Margherita before this date but I am not sure of the number of occasions.
- 3. I visited Santa Margherita on 18th and 20th August, 1943, on the latter occasion I deligered General Order No. 2, and again on 28th August, 1943, the Margor and the Marshall had visited me at Sciacca in the meantime. Upon all three visits I saw both the Mayor, his staff, and the Marshall of Carabiniere.
- 4. Had either the Mayor or the Marshall of Carabiniere been approached by the above Division they would have found that Santa Margherita has a C.A.O. and that it had been visited by an AMGOT Officer.
- 5. Acting upon instructions my headquarters were set up at Sciacca and I have enneavoured to visit each commune at least once a week and shall continue to do so.
