Subject - Report of H.Q. Combat Command "A"
2nd Armoured Division, on Santa
Margherita.



1. On 13th August, 1943 I was assigned C.A.O. in Sciacca District which embraces the communes of Sciacca, Menfi, Santa Margherita, Sambuca and Montevago. Prior to that date the C.A.O. was Major Ashworth who is now Provincial C.A.P.O. Agrigento.
2. On 14th August, 1943, Santa Margherita was visited by Major Ashworth and myself and he introduced me to the Mayor and Marshall of Carabinieri, also to a Lieutenant of the American Army whose name I cannot recall. Major Ashworth had visited Santa Margherita before this date but I am not sure of the number of occasions.
3. I visited Santa Margherita on 18th and 20th August, 1943, on the latter occasion I delivered General Order No. 2, and again on 28th August, 1943, the Mayor and the Marshall had visited me at Sciacca in the meantime. Upon all three visits I saw both the Mayor, his staff, and the Marshall of Carabinieri.
4. Had either the Mayor or the Marshall of Carabinieri been approached by the above Division they would have found that Santa Margherita has a C.A.O. and that it had been visited by an AMGOT Officer.
5. Acting upon instructions my headquarters were set up at Sciacca and I have endeavoured to visit each commune at least once a week and shall continue to do so.

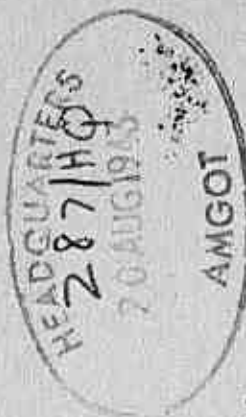

I The territory covered by the 82nd. Airborne Division, which has its headquarters here included a portion of the province of Agrigento and in particular the town of Santa Margherita.

2 The Division H.Q. has several times spoken to us about the desirability of placing a C.A.O. in Santa Margherita, or at least having that place visited from time to time by a C.A.O. We have advised them that they should take the matter up with the S.C.A.O. at Agrigento but apparently they have experienced some difficulty in doing so as they have now asked us to transmit this request through you.
