With reference to the complaint made verbally to Brigadier Parkinson D.P.H., Sub-Commission, Region I by L/Cpl D.Grainger R.A.S.C. on his inspection of the Medical Supply Depot at Caltanissetta on the IOth Dec 43.

The following facts concerning this case for promotion are submitted to you for . scrutiny and investigation as requested.

This man was serving under Major Brown R.A.M.C., S.A.P.H.O. of Syracusa from July to September this year and during that period his work was of such on high standard that the S.A.P.H.O. submitted his case to D.P.H. for promotion to Corporal (His work at this period was setting up and establishing a Provincial Med Supply Warehouse at Syracusa.).

As a result of his good work at Syracusa he was posted on the 23rd Sep 43 to Medical Supply Depot Caltanissetta for duty under my command to assist in the establishing of this Depot.

I have found him to be very conscientious, hard working and to have good capabilities for organization of Medical Supplies.

As there was no Senior N.C.O. employed at this Depot, which is very essential for the good running of a Depot, I therefore submitted his name for promotion to the rank of Sergeant (my letter Misc/43 dated I5th Oct to D.P.H. refers).

D.P.His letter AIDOT/3006/PH dated 22nd Oct 43 informed me that this man was recommended for the rank of Corporal and that the Administration Officer stated this Ka would receive favourable consideration when a vacancy occured.
