1. An enquiry has been received from a prominent Sicilian who is cooperating with A.I.G. regarding the whereabouts of his son Ensign ARRIGO.
2. This Ensign was a Cadet at the Leghorn Naval College and received his commission at about the time of the signing of the Allied-Italian Armistice.
3. Information is requested as to whether or not Ensign ARRIGO sailed with the Italian fleet for Allied Ports or whether he was retained at Leghorn.
4. It is suggested that the Royal Naval Authorities at Malta will be able to contact an Italian authority who would have nominal rolls of Italian Naval Officers who sailed to Allied ports.
5. Any information you can give will be very much appreciated.
