This staff under existing conditions is found to be inadequate. The inclusion of a clerk on the staff would help considerably in maintaining records of issues of stores, compiling indents etc. When stores, clothing have to be collected from Ordnance Dumps at Syracuse or Catania it necessitates the SQMS and 1 of the storemen being away for periods up to 5 days, thus leaving the Stores in charge of 1 man, odd men have to be found to relieve him for meals etc. which is not entirely satisfactory.

The present Staff are very conscientious in their work, thoroughly reliable and clean, SQMS Doggett is particularly reliable and has a very sound knowledge of "Q" work, he is fit to hold the appointment of RQMS if such an appointment is allowed in the new W.E.. I further suggest that one of the storemen should hold the appointment of L/C.
