TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

1. Speed Limits - The maximum speed of vehicles in the Metropolitan Area of Naples is as follows:
 - a. During daylight hours, 25 miles per hour, except streets posted otherwise.
 - b. Tunnels, 15 miles per hour.
 - c. During hours of darkness, 15 miles per hour.
 - d. Bridges, as individually marked.
2. Parking - Parking areas are provided at Piazza Plebiscito (Coords 210482) and Piazza Garibaldi. Parking is prohibited where NO PARKING signs are erected.
3. Vehicle Lights.
 - a. Forward of the Corps rear boundary total blackout will prevail, excepting where Corps Commanders have authorized blackout lights on vehicles.
 - b. In rear of the Corps rear boundary,
 - (1) Vehicles at night will use low-beam or dim headlights except during an air raid when blackout will prevail.
 - (2) The practice of throwing missiles at or firing at vehicle lights will not be tolerated.
4. Movement During Red Alert - The following restrictions are placed on vehicles:
 - a. Emergency vehicles on alert missions are authorized to move during the alert at such speeds as may be necessary to discharge operational duties. Dim-out lights may be used on such vehicles when so directed by a commissioned officer.

RESTRICTED

- b. Upon the sounding of the alarm all vehicles in motion but not on an alert mission will be immediately parked on the right-hand side of the road, close to the curb line or on the shoulder of the road. All lights will be extinguished. Street and road intersections will be kept clear.

5.. Conduct in Vehicles.

- a. Smoking by the driver of a government vehicles is not authorized while operating the vehicle.
- b. Personnel riding in motor vehicles will conduct themselves in a military manner.
- c. Not more than four (4) persons, including the driver, will be carried in 1/4-ton trucks.
- d. The transportation in government vehicles of civilians not in the employ of the Allied Forces is prohibited.

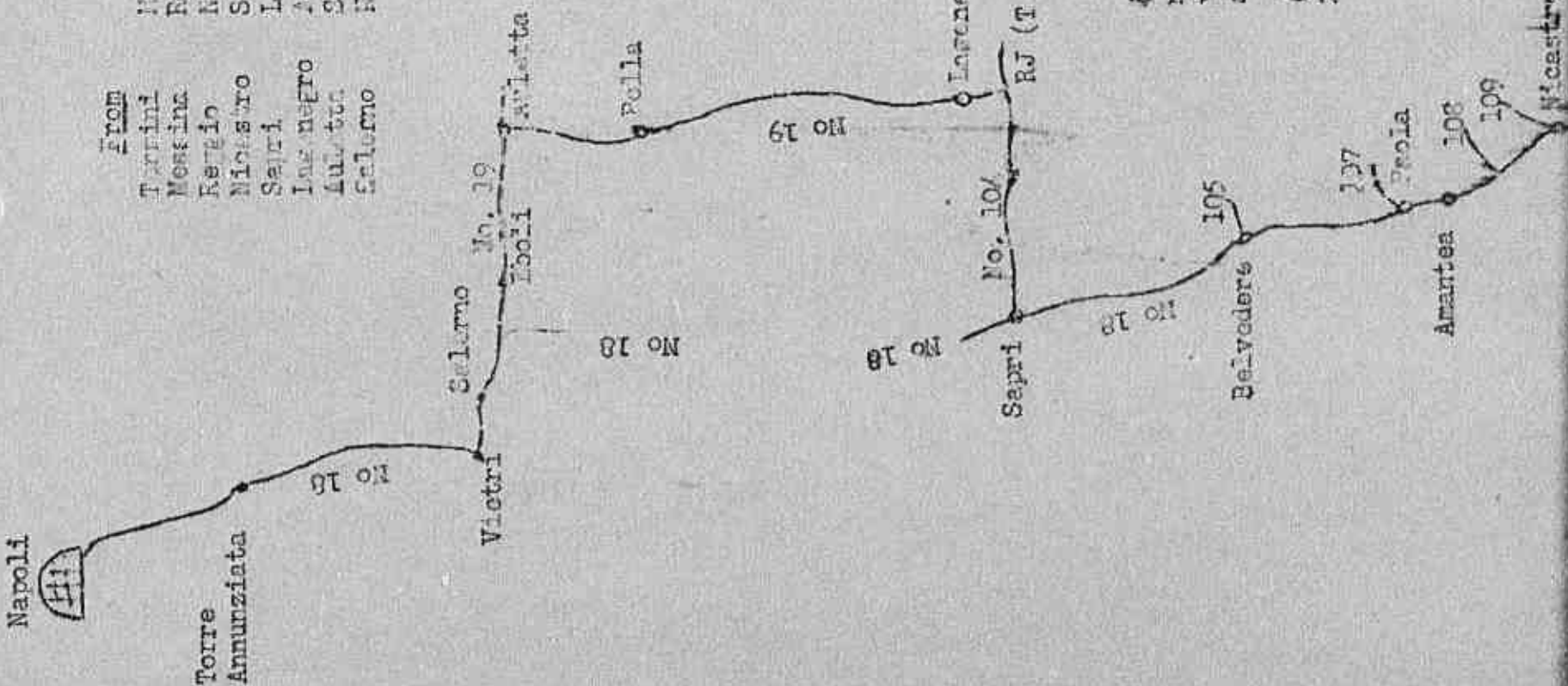
SUBJECT: Road Condition from Stefano to Messina

1. 6 mile west of San Stefano: 130 ft. one way, combination rail and highway bridge - Triple - Double Bailey.
2. 1 mile west of Stefano: Timber bridge with concrete by pass to take all weights.
3. 2 mile west of Caronia: Dirt washed in road - care should be taken in wet weather.
4. $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of Caronia: Concrete wier - High water limitation only.
5. 6 mile east of Caronia: (T. Furiano) Concrete wier. High water limitations only.
6. 7 mile west of Capo d' Orlando: Concrete wier. High water limitations only.
7. 5 mile west of Capo d' Orlando: Concrete wier. High water limitations only.
8. 6 mile west of Patti: Crater at east end of tunnel. Sharp turn to right going east. One way traffic - very dangerous - Should have control when convoy passing through.
9. Patti: Debris in streets narrows to one way. Control on Convoy.
10. Milazzo junction: Highway very rough in this area.
11. From 9 mile from Messina to Messina the road is steep and very crooked. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ton with trailers can make turns if great care is used. Larger vehicles would have considerable difficulty and should attempt only in daylight. Many 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ drivers will have some trouble. 3 bomb holes in this area causing one way traffic around them.
12. Summary: No normal convoy should have difficulty over this route if care is used at tunnel and in area prior to Messina.
13. This information gained 15-16 October 1943.

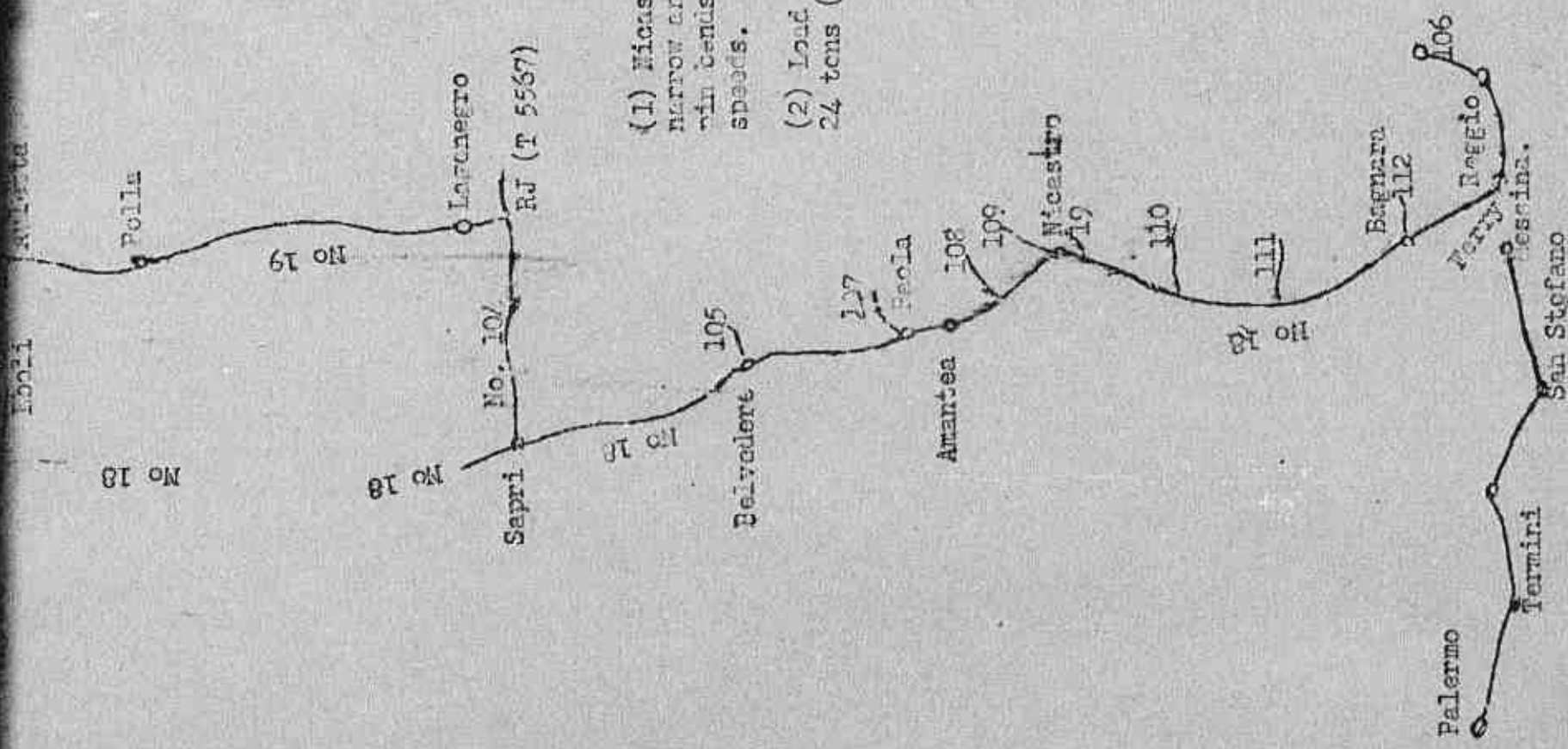
ROUTE MAP - 9 OCTOBER 1943

SUBJECT: Tini Guseu Rear Party Hq ACC

TO : Military Government Section, AFHQ (2 copies)

1. Reference your cable Number 12362 dated 11 December 1943 and ours in reply Number 1179 of 13 December 1943. It is considered most desirable that the Hq ACC Rear Party, including Hq 207th American Regt and British Admin. Hq should be sent forward as soon as circumstances permit remaining personnel at Tini Guseu being constituted a detachment under your command.

2. There appears to be no object now in sending the party to Palermo to join the Rear Detachment unless with your knowledge of the transportation situation you consider this advisable as facilitating their onward move to Naples/Salerma in due course. There is no difficulty about accommodation at Palermo.

3. The party should therefore proceed direct by sea to Naples where they can be accepted any time after 24 December. Officers dispatched independently and ahead of the Main Party can be accepted at any time. (See para. 6 and 7 below)

4. It is not known whether transportation conditions will admit of the party being sent en bloc as assumed above, or whether it will be a matter of sending personnel forward by tons and threes by air or other means as opportunity offers. In any event it is requested that personnel already asked for as urgently required should be sent forward independently of the Main Party.

5. I report from the Hq ACC Rear Party proper (i.e. the party referred to in your cable Number 8458 dated 2 December 1943) additional officers are required to fill vacancies in Hq ACC to which officers have never been assigned. It is requested that such officers be provided from the "pool" at Tini Guseu - i.e. those officers originally assigned to Regions 6 and 7.

6. In order to provide for the situation outlined in paragraphs 4 and 5 above, it is necessary to indicate an order of priority and also the officers whom it is desired should be sent forward independently ahead of the Main Party, should the intention be to move the latter en bloc. (In this connection, while due note is taken of your Circular No. 82 dated 10 December 1943, it may be observed incidentally that it has been the experience of many officers in this organization that aircraft seldom travel without empty seats.)

7. The priority referred to above is given in para. 4 and 5 attached.

It is not known whether transportation conditions will admit of the party being sent en bloc as assumed above, or whether it will be a matter of sending personnel forward by two and thence by air or other means as opportunity offers. In any event it is requested that personnel already asked for as urgently required should be sent forward independently of the Main Party.

5. Apart from the Hq AGO Rear Party proper (i.e. the party referred to in your cable Number 8458 dated 2 December 1943) additional officers are required to fill vacancies in Hq AGO to which officers have never been assigned. It is requested that such officers be provided from the "pool" at Tish Qazou - i.e. those officers originally assigned to Regions 8 and 9.

6. In order to provide for the situation outlined in paragraphs 4 and 5 above, it is necessary to indicate an order of priority and also the officers whom it is desired should be sent forward independently ahead of the Main Party, should the intention be to move the latter en bloc. (In this connection, while due note is taken of your Circular No. 52 dated 10 December 1943, it may be observed incidentally that it has been the experience of many officers in this organization that aircraft seldom travel without empty seats.)

7. a. The priority referred to above is given in App. A and B attached. 3187
b. Appendix A consists of requests for officers by appointment, who are required for urgent duties, largely in connection with the various moves now pending. They involve a number of administrative appointments. It will be appreciated that the division of Hq AGO into 20 many separated echelons greatly increases the number of administrative officers required. In two cases, names have been suggested.

c. Appendix B consists of a nominal roll (in order of priority) of specialist officers who are urgently required for the Sub-Commissions shown. It takes precedence after Appendix A. The first six officers in the list should be sent independently and ahead of the Main Party - if possible by air. They have been marked with 6 crosses.

d. In the case of both appendices, the officers named are believed to

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be at Elm Ouzon, though not necessarily in the ACC Rear Party proper (see para. 5 above.) You will realize, however, that it may well be that some are en route and others have been dispatched on other assignments. All officers dispatched independently and ahead of the Main Party should be sent to Naples.

5. After demands in Apps. A and B have been satisfied, the next priority is all officers of the original ACC Rear Party (see para. 5) not included in Apps. A and B. After that, it is considered that officers will be required with the qualifications and in the order shown below:
