6. ITALIAN GOVERNMENT WILL BE INFORMED GENERALLY AS ABOVE WITH DUE REGARD SECURITY AND THAT THERE IS NO JUSTIFICATION PLEAD INABILITY ACCEPT ITALIAN REFUGEES ON GROUNDS LACK OF SUPPLIES.

7. QUESTIONS ON ANY ADDITIONAL ALLOCATIONS, SUBSEQUENT SUPPLIES AND LOCAL STOCKPILING WILL BE TAKEN UP DIRECT BETWEEN DIRECTOR OF REFUGEES AND CENTRAL ECONOMIC COMMITTEE.

8. AMG 15 ARMY GROUP WILL INFORM CENTRAL ECONOMIC COMMITTEE DIRECT OF EXACT REQUIREMENTS FOR SUPPLIES FOR RECEPTION CAMPS PARTICULARLY DATE OF FIRST CONSIGNMENT, PERIODIC QUANTITIES AND LOCATION. CENTRAL ECONOMIC COMMITTEE WILL ARRANGE SUPPLIES AND TRANSPORTATION OF SUPPLIES FOR FEEDING ~~10000~~ AT EACH CAMP.

9. SEPARATE MESSAGE FOLLOWS CONNECTION SUPPLIES REFERRED TO IN FLAMBO 7108 OF 4 JANUARY.

Displaced persons and Italian refugees subject.

1. Supplies dealt with in cable even date.
2. 10 Officers already called forward and leave by air for Brindisi 12 January.
3. Officers and EM/ORS additionally required by director refugees displaced persons should be borrowed from region 5. Latter left 10 January to join region 2 eta Taranto 18 January consisting 92 officers 153 EM/ORS 27 Vehicles. 70 of these EM/ORS are region 8 and 9 personnel.
4. Fargo have undertaken send one CR CAR 2 Jeeps 43-quarter W/CS to assist director as 1 ST installment allocation necessary vehicles.
5. Additional personnel for AMG 15 Army for forward evacuation should be borrowed from 1 ST party regions 8 and 9 eta Naples 19 January comprising 70 officers 17 red cross 150 EM/ORS. Balance of 70 EM/ORS travelling with region 5 see paragraph 3 above.
6. Inform soonest result conference with distwo provision camps tentage and transportation.

For MACFARLANE from MATHEWS. Understand all evacuation staff will be posted on TO YCXM Subcommission.

1. Essential I receive 615 GWT trucks and 2 light vehicles with drivers.

2. 3 Officers required, one with Q experience total of 5. 6 NCOs required, 2 with Q experience. 2 competent clerks. Suggest all British in view difficulties pay rations for Americans enlisted men.

3. Cited cross stores required as follows: 10,000 blankets. 10 tons tinned milk. Boots and shoes for unit of 10,000 proportioned 70% women and children 30% men.

4. Large store tents. All to be consigned to Evacuation 86 Area. HOLMES here concurs.
