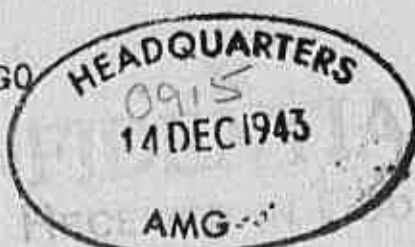

1. Basic communication presages a problem parallel to that now being handled in 8th Army Area.

2. This particular phase of activity was not contemplated or considered when the plans and tables of D.P. Subcommittee were prepared but is now believed to be a natural concomitant of the work to be done in the interest of the military operations and falls within the directive as supervising Italian agencies with relation to displaced Italians. Such an Italian agency is now functioning re: evacuees and displaced Italians in 8th Army zone.

3. Two experienced evacuation officers are at present working with 8th Army. Others of the same calibre will be required, on an attached basis, if we are to extend our evacuation activities to 5th Army. The following officers are recommended and from this list two should be available, three desirable:

a. Capt E. Bolton	East Africa
b. Lt S. Gaylard	East Africa
c. Capt Johnson	Middle East
d. Capt J. Robertson	Middle East
e. Lt T. Wheeler	East Africa
f. Lt Channing	Middle East.

All of these officers went through the evacuation of Ethiopia, Somaliland and/or Eritrea, and it is believed that there exists no further problem of that kind in East Africa. D.P. Subcommittee has but enough officers to do the work required in existing camps, and none of the officers at hand has any special qualifications in evacuating civilians.

4. I am prepared to send forward one American Officer who can handle the present situation, which apparently presents no immediate problem. He will be briefed here sufficiently to implement the initial requirements.

5. ANGOT, 15th Army Group should be reminded that it will be necessary for the Italian Committee to be prepared to widen the scope of its responsibilities to include provinces south of 5th Army zone.

6. It is the recollection of the undersigned that Col
