SUBJECT: Non-Secret Short Title Unit Designations.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Circular Number 75 and Section I, Circular Number 79, this headquarters, 1943, are being rescinded and the following substituted therefor.

2. The following non-secret short titles are approved to designate the units indicated below for use in all communications in this Theater when brevity of the transmitted material is a paramount consideration. These short titles are not secret code words for units, but are merely to be used for brevity in messages in place of the full name of the unit. Subordinate commands will submit additional proposed non-secret short titles for elements of their command to this headquarters for approval and announcement. 41

3. For uniformity and to avoid confusion, no other non-secret abbreviations or non-secret short titles should be used for these units. The purpose of these short titles is brevity in the preparation of messages and to facilitate the transmission of messages by electrical means. The short title is to be used in the text of the message in place of the whole name of a unit or installation. They are not to be used in addressing official correspondence. All new short title names or changes in non-secret short titles will be approved and announced by this headquarters.

4. For convenience, the list of Short Title Unit Designations is in two parts; Part I being the units or organizations listed alphabetically and Part II being the Short Title Unit Designations listed alphabetically.

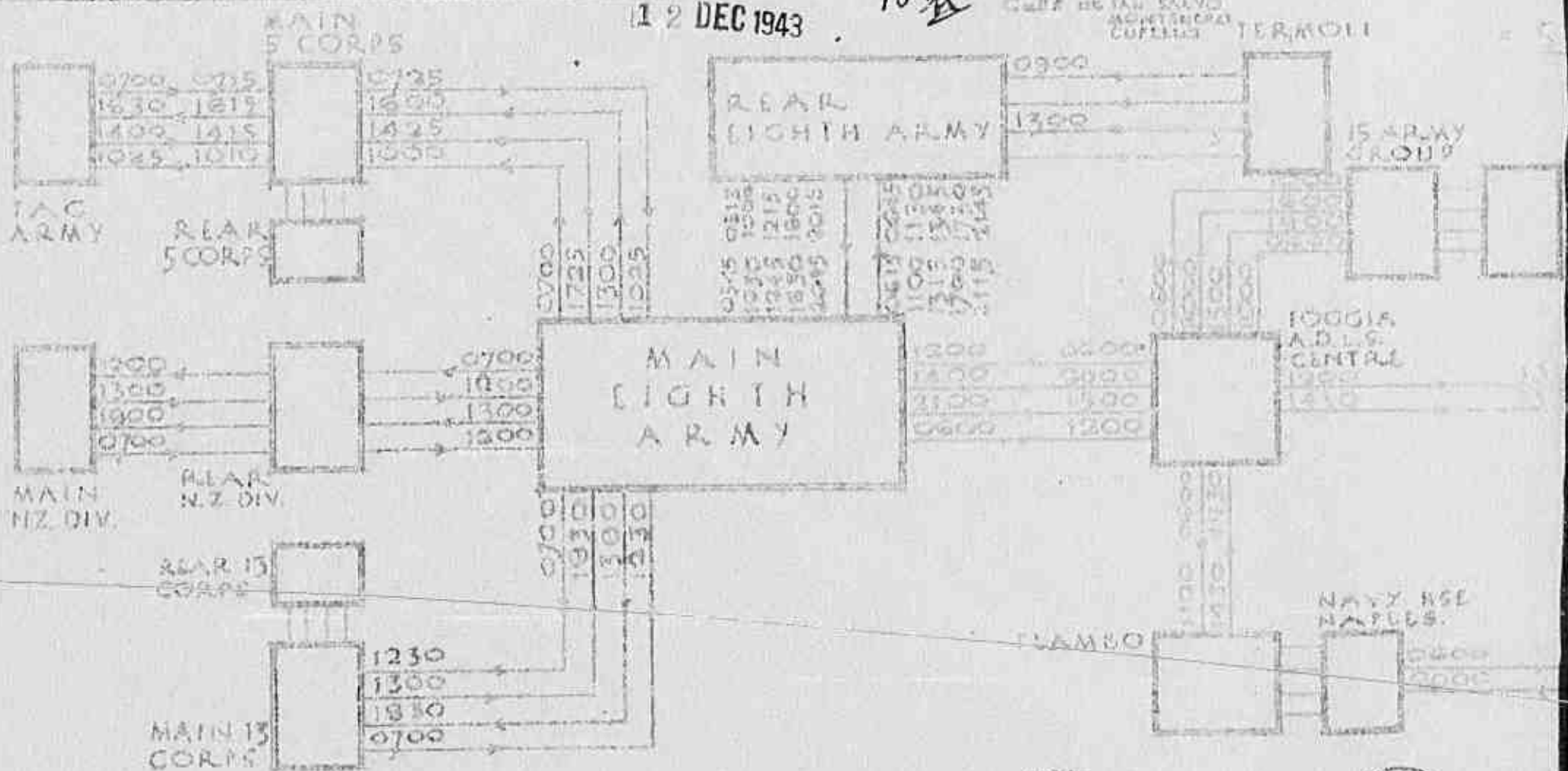

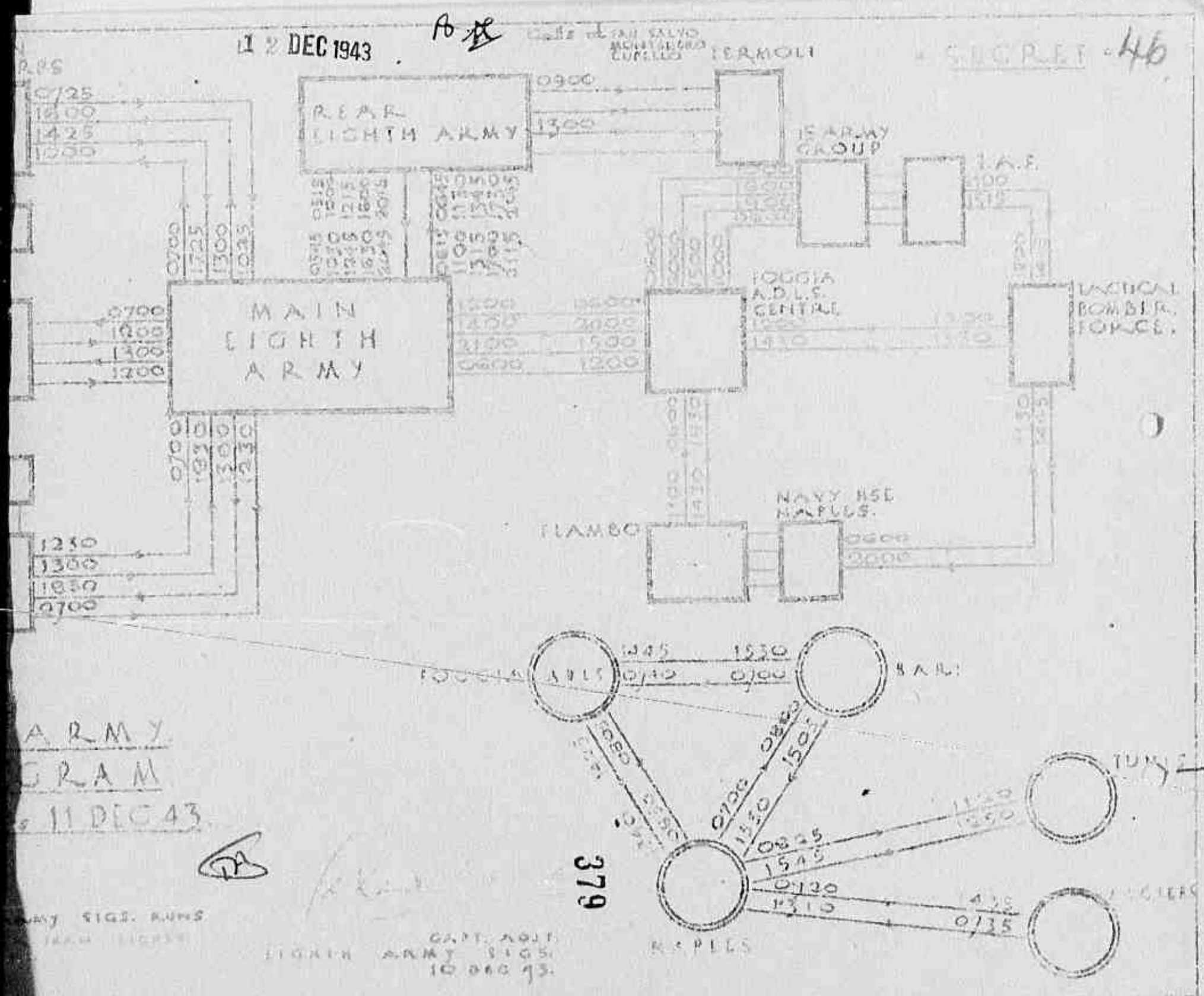

SUBJECT: Unauthorized Use of MDLS, ADLS and ACS Services.

TO : All concerned.

1. Investigation indicates that it has become almost universal practice throughout this theater to dispatch via Motor Dispatch Letter Service, Air Dispatch Letter Service and Army Courier Service, often under official franking, communications and packages which are purely personal. Shoes, underwear and other personal items have been discovered where packages have broken open in transit. This practice has resulted in a considerable increase of MDLS, ADLS and ACS loads which are entirely unwarranted and unnecessary and have interfered with the proper transmission of official matter.

2. The MDLS, ADLS and ACS services are provided for transmitting official mail only, as outlined in letters this headquarters, file AG 311.1-5 AGM, dated 11 July 1943 and 1 November 1943, and Signal Instruction numbers 84 and 85, this headquarters, cs.

3. Immediately upon receipt of this letter, Commanding Officers of units and formations stationed in this theater, British and U.S., will acquaint all concerned with the contents of this letter and issue explicit instructions that under no circumstances will other than official communications be transmitted by MDLS, ADLS, and ACS.

4. Effective immediately, all personnel on duty with MDLS, ADLS and ACS will be instructed to decline to accept any envelope or package unless it has on it the following statement: ESSENTIAL (WAR DEPARTMENT) (WAR OFFICE MAIL) and signed by an officer whose name, rank and unit will be clearly shown.

5. Officers in charge of MDLS, ADLS and ACS and officers of the Adjutant General's Department engaged in the handling or transmission of official documents are authorized to open packages or letters suspected to be of an unofficial nature, special care will be taken that no material bearing an indication that the material is operational is opened. Material found to have been mailed in violation of this directive will be held and a brief report made direct to this headquarters, attention of the Adjutant General, showing:

- a. Description of the envelope or package.
- b. Place from which dispatched.
- c. The name, rank and unit of officer who certified the article to be official.

2. ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WHEREBY BAILEY BRIDGES IN CALABRIA WILL NOT BE REMOVED UNTIL DIVERSIONS OR SUBSTITUTE BRIDGES HAVE BEEN CONSTRUCTED BY THE ITALIAN ARMY.
3. 1. The Senior Civil Affairs Officer of LUCANIA reports that certain BAILEY bridges erected in No. 2 District have been, and will be, removed for use elsewhere. In particular he is anxious to know if it is intended to remove the bridge at LAGONERO, as this would not only sever communications between POTENZA and CALABRIA except by the circuitous coast route, but would virtually maroon certain areas in need of supplies.
2. It is fully realised that the transfer of Bailey bridges to areas where demolitions are impeding the prosecution of the war, is essential.
3. I write to enquire whether you can advise this Headquarters of any programme that is contemplated for the removal of BAILEY bridges in No.2 District, in order that arrangements may be made in advance for the use of alternative lines of communication.

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The question of the resumption of postal and
Telegraphic services has come to the fore.

2. The present system of Military Government in this
Region whereby control is exercised largely through the Provincial capital,
makes it essential that communications be re-established on a normal
basis as soon as possible.

3. Before resuming these services it is necessary that
we receive authority from you. Such authority presumably will depend in
part upon the agreement of G.S.I. (b), 8 Army. Although 8 Army appears
not to be particularly interested in Region 2 there are still sections
of the Field Security Service operating in the area. This S.S. is of the
