1. In order to clear up confusion which has arisen as to the correct use of the above addresses and names, a definition and explanation of use of each type are contained in the following paragraphs. The instructions included will be strictly followed by all concerned.
2. Telegraphic Addresses.
 - (a) These are non-secret addresses registered with civilian Cable and Wireless concerns, for use over their communication channels. They are registered only for addressees for whom communications may have to be transmitted over civilian channels.
 - (b) As telegraphic addresses are used only by intercommunication personnel, they are not notified to originators of Signal messages.
 - (c) Applications for a registered address will be submitted to this H.Q. The application will contain a suggested address, not over 15 nor less than 6 letters in length, followed by the geographical location.
 - (d) Registration of an approved address with civilian agencies will be carried out by A.P.H.Q., and the date on which it may be taken into use will be notified to the Signal authorities concerned.
 - (e) When a H.Q. changes location and cannot be served by the existing telegraphic address, an application will be made requesting cancellation of the address and the registration of a new one.
3. Signal Addresses.
 - (a) A Signal address is non-secret and consists of a simple code word, usually bearing some relation in formulation or spelling to the full title of the H.Q. It is an abbreviated address for use by originators of Signal messages in place of the full title, where the latter is lengthy or confusing.
 - (b) Appendix "A" shows existing signal addresses which have been authorized by A.P.H.Q. Amendments to the Appendix will be notified as they occur.
 - (c) Signal addresses will NOT in any circumstances be used in lieu of Army secret code words allotted for a special purpose to corresponding H.Q. or units.
 - (d) Signal addresses will, as the title implies, be used only on Signal messages. No abbreviations other than those authorized will be used for the H.Q.s concerned.
 - (e) Applications for allotment of a Signal address will be made to this H.Q. and will contain a suggested address.
4. Telephone Code Names.

These are non-secret addresses registered with civilian cable and wireless concerns, for use over their communication channels. They are registered only for addresses for which communications may have to be transmitted over civilian channels.

- (b) As telegraphic addresses are used only by intercommunication personnel, they are not notified to originators of Signal messages.

- (c) Signal addresses will NOT in any circumstances be used in lieu of Army secret code words allotted for a special purpose to corresponding H.Q. or units.
- (d) Signal addresses will, as the title implies, be used only on Signal messages. No abbreviations other than those authorised will be used for the H.Q.s concerned.
- (e) Applications for allotment of a Signal address will be made to this H.Q. and will contain a suggested address.

4. Telephone Code Names.

- (a) These are allotted to the Main H.Q. and installations, down to H.Q. Army Group level in British Army formations and to all H.Q. and units of American formations.
- (b) They are non-secret and intended only for use in telephone communication, to facilitate routing of calls by exchange operators. (When the telephone code name is the same as the Signal address, it may, of course, be used for both purposes).
- (c) In no circumstances may a telephone code name be used as an identification of a H.Q. or unit over radio communications.
- (d) Appendix "B" shows the current telephone code names of Main H.Q. 429 installations. Amendments will be issued as they occur.

- 5. Sufficient copies are enclosed for distribution to all Branches and Signal units at your H.Q. Extracts, as required, will be made for the use of junior formations.
