4. Changes of assignment of ACO and AAG personnel:

I -- DEFECTIVE AMMUNITION LOT

1. All Rockets, 2.36", AT, M6, of lot number DOD 1-23303-3 are suspended from issue and will be withdrawn from service and returned to base section depots.

II - BASIC AMMUNITION LOADS

Troop Units which have drawn a basic ammunition load will retain this basic ammunition load or its equivalent in their possession and carry it when moved except that if the move is by sea, the movement orders will state what types and amounts shall be retained and the disposition of the balance of the basic load.

III - DEALING IN STAMPS AND CURRENCY

CFO  
1. All members of the armed forces and persons serving with or accompanying such forces are forbidden to offer by advertisement or to engage in the business of dealing in any currency or postage stamps issued by the Allied Military Government or by any other governmental authority within this theater.

2. The foregoing does not apply to the sending of currency, coins and postage stamps in small numbers and denominations, as souvenirs, in private communications.

IV - RESTORATION TO DUTY OF GENERAL PRISONERS

1. The confinement of general prisoners in this theater under sentences in which the execution of the dishonorable discharge is suspended is intended to afford such prisoners an opportunity to be restored to duty. This restoration is accomplished by suspending the execution of the unexecuted portion of the sentence and assigning the soldier to a Personnel Center for further assignment.

2. The sentence so suspended would normally remain suspended during the whole of the soldier's service. In order that the soldier's record may be completely cleared of the suspended sentence, company and similar unit commanders will, at the expiration of six months from the time the soldier is restored to duty, recommend to the officer exercising general court-martial jurisdiction over his unit that the suspended sentence be remitted, provided the soldier has demonstrated his fitness for complete restoration. As a reward for bravery or exceptional service a unit commander may, at any time after a general prisoner has been restored to duty under a suspended sentence, recommend that the sentence be remitted without regard to the six months' period.

V -- 3" GUN MOTOR CARRIAGES M10 AND M10A1

The following instructions from the Headquarters, Army Ground Forces, Washington, D. C. are directed to the attention of all concerned.

a. It has been brought to the attention of this headquarters that certain tank destroyer battalions have welded the sprocket, front to the hub, drive sprocket on M10 and M10A1, in order to eliminate shearing of bolts which are used to secure sprocket to hub.

b. These bolts are specially designed as the weakest link in the power train and acessive strain is indicated when they shear. Welding, as described above, eliminates the safety factor which is thus interposed in driving mechanism to protect the power train.

c. It has been found that these drive sprocket bolts need frequent tightening and that shearing usually occurs when vehicles are operated with these bolts loose. Outside bolts are generally kept tight while those on the inside sprocket, which are more difficult to reach, are neglected.

d. The practice of welding sprockets to hubs will be immediately discontinued and vehicles already modified in this unauthorized manner will be returned to their original condition without delay.

MEMORANDUM ON POSTAL SERVICE FOR PERSONNEL OF 2657th REGIMENT A. C. C.

1. In order for satisfactory postal service to be rendered all American personnel of the Allied Control Commission and Allied Military Government, APO 394 has been established and will operate at Headquarters, Allied Control Commission. This APO number is to be used as the mail address, for both official and personal mail, by all personnel of the Commission and Regiment. One exception is Company "F" (Region VI), Sardinia, which will continue to use APO 397.

2. It will be understood that APO 394 does not operate as a post office in the customary sense. Mail for all the personnel of the regiment will not be delivered, sorted, and redistributed at the location of this APO. The Postal Service MATOUSA has been notified of the geographical location of every unit of the regiment as listed in Regimental APO Bulletins and Special Orders and promulgated for the information of all concerned. Mail, properly addressed in accordance therewith to the regimental unit, APO 394, will be redirected by the Army Postal Service and routed through the APO currently serving the particular organization, in order to ensure the promptest possible delivery.

3. A complete and accurate mail directory section should be operated at Headquarters, 2675th Regiment, A.C.C., (Forward Echelon); and Headquarters, 2675th Regiment, A.C.C., (Rear Echelon). These sections should maintain card files showing locations of all personnel on duty with the regiment. Proper record will be made of all changes within the organization in order that mail can be properly re-addressed and forwarded without delay.

4. Each company should maintain a card file showing locations of all personnel on duty with such company. Proper record should be made of all changes within the organization in order that mail can be properly re-addressed and forwarded without delay.

5. On change of location of any regimental unit, Headquarters 2675th Reg't. should at once advise AG Postal, MATOUSA, of the new geographical address of the unit in order that the Postal Service may without delay properly re-address mail to the APO serving that locality. Company Commanders on change of location should establish immediate contact with the APO unit serving their new area.

6. Change of address cards, NAP Forms 11 and 12, are attached. Such forms are available at all APOs and all personnel should immediately complete and mail such cards to the following:

Postal Officer, APO 394  
Postal Officer, APO 512

7. Personnel should advise their correspondents of their new APO number, showing the unit designation, as listed in Regimental APO Bulletin or Special Order. V-mail change of address forms should be used for this purpose if available.

8. The cable address of all personnel of the regiment is AMUSHA, with the exception of personnel on duty with Company "F" (Region VI). (See para. 1).

POSTAL - CHRISTMAS ARRANGEMENTS.

1. PARCELS.

- (a) A gift parcel will not exceed 5 lbs. in weight and if it contains foodstuff, will not contain more than 2 lbs. of any particular foodstuff.
- (b) The contents of a parcel will be described on the wrapper showing, for Customs purposes, the weight and value of each article enclosed.
- (c) All parcels addressed to U.K. are liable to Customs Duty. Those bearing A.P. W.5492 (Duty Free Label) are exempt from duty subject to the conditions shown on the label. The duty free label is not in a position to furnish any information regarding the amount of customs duty payable on particular articles.
- (d) Many parcels are being found at Base Army Post Offices in a damaged condition due to insecure packing. Senders will ensure that all parcels are properly packed and clearly addressed - IF IN A BAG, IT IS RESPONSIBLE.
- (e) If a tie-on-label is used, the address should appear on the wrapper. If this is not possible, a slip with the full name and address should be enclosed inside the parcel.
- (f) Unit ownership of Christmas parcels will be carried out in the usual way.

2. AIR MAIL LETTER CARDS.

- (a) The rate of AMLC will be increased to £10 per officer and OR during the week ended 6, 13, 20, 27 Nov and 4 Dec 43.
- (b) One of these AMLC may be posted free each week free of postage.
- (c) Each "postage free" AMLC will have the word "FREE" written by the sender in the top right hand corner.
- (d) The Post Office will make special arrangements for the delivery of these during Christmas week.

3. AIRTEL.

- (a) As there is no restriction on the number of airmgrams which 8410 posted, soldiers are advised to use them for Christmas Greetings.
- (b) An airmgram specially designed for use as a Christmas Greetings Card will be obtainable at all British ARMs in the DMZ and CWP. There is no charge for the form, but the postage rate is 3d. or airmgram.
- (c) These special airmgrams will be forwarded to the country of destination as soon as they are posted but special arrangements have been made to ensure delivery during Christmas week. It is an advantage to post these airmgrams AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE and all ranks are asked to co-operate.

4. CHRISTMAS CARDS.

As postage up to 2d. is free for surface mail, it is not necessary to stick in the flap of envelopes containing Christmas Cards. Unit censors

(f) Unit censorship of Christmas parcels will be carried out in the usual way.

## 2. AIRMAIL LETTER CARDS.

(a) The ration of AILC will be increased to TWO per officer and OR during the week ended 6, 13, 20, 27 Nov and 4 Dec 43.

(b) One of these AILC may be posted free of charge from the Post Office.

(c) Each "postage free" AILC will have the word "FREE" written by the sender in the top right hand corner.

(d) The Post Office will make special arrangements for the delivery of these during Christmas week.

## 3. AIRCRAFT.

(a) As there is no restriction on the number of airmails which 8410 posted, soldiers are advised to use them for Christmas Greetings.

(b) An airmail specially designed for use as a Christmas Greetings Card will be obtainable at all British APOs in the BHP and CTF. There is no charge for the Card, but the postage rate is 3d per airmail.

(c) These special airmails will be forwarded to the country of destination as soon as they are posted but special arrangements have been made to ensure delivery during Christmas week. It is an advantage to post these airmails AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE and all ranks are asked to co-operate.

## 4. CHRISTMAS CARDS.

As postage up to 2 oz is free for surface mail, it is not necessary to tack in the flaps of envelopes containing Christmas Cards. Unit censors will ensure that all envelopes are sealed before posting.

## 5. TELEGRAMS.

(a) The ARMY and Letter Telegram service will be suspended from 15 Dec 43 to 4 Jan 44.

(b) The number of Concession (CMT) Telegrams which can be sent only for URGENT family or business reasons will be increased from one to two per the month of Dec 43 only (CMT 61/43 rules).

This figure is confirmed by the local A.P.O. and obviously compares very unfavourably with the situation in this Province as outlined in first para. above.

It is suggested that the delay may be caused through letters being addressed to 15 Army Group, and it is requested, therefore, that if this is the case, the correct address be notified, please.
