EXTRACT FROM STARS AND STRIPES, ITALY
DATED 12 NOVEMBER 1943

BOARD TO HELP ITALIAN SELF RULE SET UP BY ALLIES
Allied Force Headquarters, Nov 11.

The United Nations acted today to speed the replacement of Allied Military Government in Italy with a limited Italian administration,

The action came with the appointment by General Dwight D. Eisenhower of an Allied Control Commission for Italy, under the presidency of Major General Kenyon A. Joyce, "charged with" carrying out the terms of the Armistice and aligning Italian economy in complete support of the United Nations fight against Germany". The plan does not mean Italian territory will be returned to unrestricted control, General Eisenhower made clear.

General Kenyon's headquarters will be at the seat of the present Italian government and he will be responsible directly to General Eisenhower.

"The Commission has control of military and economic activities of Italy as envisaged in the terms of the Armistice", General Eisenhower said in announcing the appointment.

"Italy has now a role in the war" the Allied Commander continued. "That role is to fight the common enemy - Germany. The Control Commission will see that all of Italy's economic resources and manpower are utilized where they can do the most good in the fight."

"In all areas behind combat zones the Allied Military Government will gradually be replaced by Italian administration exercised under supervision of the Control Commission. We look to the Italian Government to broaden its political composition and strengthen its administrative structure and the transfer from AMG to Italian administration will keep with this development."

"This does not mean return of Italian territory to unrestricted Italian control", the General said.

"AMG still goes forward with the 15th Army Group to organize territory as the Germans are expelled and continues to press onward as a spearhead taking charge of communities disorganized by the Nazi's retreat and destruction of civic life once burdened with fascism and clearing a path immediately for future military movements toward the front"

Dear Sir,

On behalf of the International Committee for the Search of Jewish refugees from Europe, on which a number of Italian representatives are serving, I have pleasure in asking for your collaboration in our humane work.

This Committee would be grateful if you could kindly supply:

- (1) As complete as possible a list of Italian Jews resident in the liberated part of S. Italy - Jews regularly registered with the Naples Community and with other communities in S. Italy or in Italian island territory, or Jews who have fled to S. Italy from Central or North Italy (before or since the armistice and the German invasion;
- (2) As complete as possible a list of foreign Jews (Poles, Yugoslavs, Austrians, Germans etc.,) in S. Italy, whether free, interned, restricted, prisoners etc. (although, incidentally, there is every reason to believe that they are now all freed).

In particular, we should be grateful for any information about Italian or foreign Jews who have relations in Great Britain or in N. or S. America, so that we may take steps to re-establish contact between these unhappy people and their dear ones.

On my part, I shall do all I can as soon as permission is obtained, to ensure that you are sent a complete list of all Italian Jews resident here, and registered with local aid societies. Up to date I am able, at all events, to give you excellent news of all Jews living here, who are contributing one and all, to the best of their ability, to the country's war effort.
