I have received an application from an Italian named BURZACHECHI, Quinto Amelio, to be repatriated to Calabria on medical grounds. He has been examined by the Principal Medical Officer to the Administration, who recommends his repatriation. The man is suffering from an intractable skin disease which withstands every treatment in this country, and it is believed that further treatment in Italy will finally eradicate it.

I would be most grateful if you would consider this case. BURZACHECHI has relatives at Via Poerio 86, Catanzaro, Calabria.
