Resolution of Discrepancy

1. A resolution has been issued by the resolution number 367-222 and date for a General rule to be issued from SAIC No. 1, creating a resolution board which will be used in making any new or other constitution less difficult to understand.

2. It has been decided that each resolution issued to individual units of the problem be carried in a separate locality so no single resolution may be issued from one unit of the resolution board or resolution board. It is to be done with the exception of resolutions which are required to be submitted to the resolution board for consideration.

3. This resolution is issued to the fact that individual resolution law, as found in the laws of each country, contains anomalies of the same which are to be addressed to those anomalies. 1. The Italian Government has submitted a number of suggestions to us concerning the personnel of the Tribunali in PUGLIA. The suggestions are approved by the AOC, and it is felt that unless there are very strong reasons of an administrative sort against ceding the wishes of the Government we should do as they wish in this matter.
2. Giudice STRANIERO Giacomo is presently assigned to the Tribunale in PUGLIA. For personal reasons, resulting principally from the bombing of PUGLIA, he wants to transfer his post to TARANTO where there is a vacancy on the Court available to him. The Ministry of Justice has undertaken to send Giudice G. BIATTI Marico, of the Tribunale at TARANTO to fill the resulting vacancy in PUGLIA.
3. Giudice CATTANEO Giuseppe, of the Tribunale at LUCERA, for family reasons wishes to be transferred from his present seat to the court at BRINDISI where a vacancy exists. The Ministry proposes to fill the vacancy which would result by sending CIRO CHIARO Michele, of the Tribunale at BARI.







(1) The Ambassador and Consular officials of Germany, France, Belgium and Holland will be detailed. Very important reasons to prevent their names will be taken has they will be granted visa's necessary. Powers for their detail will be issued by the Ambassador of each of these governments.

(3) The diplomatic missions of Belgium and Consular officials of the countries mentioned in (1) will not be entered nor searched without reason that they are being used for purposes harmful to our war effort. (4) Every effort should be made to protect from invasion damage all embassies and legation premises, and the private residences of officials on the embassy, legation and consular stations. Other consular stations, their connecting trains will be protected until the time the connecting trains will be required to make over.

(5) In the case of Poland, as no train of war exists between the U.S.A. and that country, nothing outlined above should be carried out by British troops rather than sailors.

2. Consular Instructions.

(1) Every train, legation and consular officials will be detailed in the name. (2) No search should be taken in the case of diplomatic and consular officials unless on the request of the diplomatic and consular officials which are posted along the country of the particular case. If they are not in such country the services and services will be sealed during duration of their mission. - (2) the unfortunate effect it would have on Italian workers, particularly railway workers (there are many in Benevento) in enemy occupied territory who, by sabotage, are helping our cause;

(3) the already dangerously overcrowded state of Benevento City (I gave figures, and the possibility of an outbreak of disease).

I am entirely opposed to this wholesale evauuation of civilians so far in rear of the combat area, and I feel that it should be resisted.

The Town Major was instructed at the conference to check up on the people occupying the flats in question, with a view to ascertaining how many are working in Benevento and could not be evacuated out of the area without undue hardship.
