Memorandum:

To : Manchukuo Minister

The Commanding General, 5th Army Division at German Army Group "C" has directed me to inform you that subject to confirmation of the availability of transport, the members of the Manchukuo Embassy staff at Bolzano will be transferred by air to Montecatini on 16 May 1945.

Baggage to be transferred will consist of personal effects only and will be limited as follows:

Officials of the equivalent rank of general officers of the armed forces	--- 350 lbs
Officials of the equivalent rank of officers other than general officers	--- 175 lbs
Adult members of officer's families	--- 175 lbs
Personnel not of officer status	--- 100 lbs

Baggage will be subject to examination prior to departure.

Personal funds, as previously declared, in the hands of members of the staff will be retained, subject to such disposition as may be determined on arrival at destination.

Transportation and escort will arrive at the Manchukuo Embassy at Bolzano at 0830 hrs, 16 May and loading will be completed 15 time to depart at 0900 hrs.

To : Macintosh Minister

The Commanding General, 5th Army Division at German Army Group "C" has directed me to inform you that subject to confirmation of the availability of transport, the members of the Macintosh Embassy staff at Warsaw will be transferred by air to Montevideo on 16 May 1945.

Baggage to be transferred will consist of personal effects only and will be limited as follows:

Officials of the equivalent rank of general officers of the armed forces	--- 350 lbs
Officials of the equivalent rank of officers other than general officers	--- 175 lbs
Adult members of officer's families	--- 175 lbs
Personal not of officer status	--- 100 lbs

Baggage will be subject to examination prior to departure.

Personal funds, as previously declared, in the hands of members of the staff will be retained, subject to such disposition as may be determined on arrival at destination.

Transportation and escort will arrive at the Macintosh Embassy at Warsaw at 0830 hrs, 16 May and loading will be completed in time to depart at 0900 hrs.
