STANDARD SIGNAL OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS
FOR THE FIFTH ARMY LIAISON DETACHMENT

14 May 1945

Outgoing Messages:

1. On all outgoing messages there will be three copies, one original and two carbon. On receiving the message in Message Center it will be given an outgoing number and a date time group. One carbon copy will be returned to the originating section as soon as this is accomplished. The other two copies will remain in the Message Center for processing, enciphering, etc.
2. After the message has been set up in code and cleared to the addressee, the original will be returned to the originating section who will sign a buck slip for it. On the original copy will be the time the message cleared to the addressee(s).
3. The second carbon will not be returned to the section. That copy is destroyed by the code room.
4. The originating section will be shown on all outgoing messages.

Messenger and Air Service:

1. There will be air service between the Liaison Detachment and Fifth Army Forward. All letters and official mail must be in the Message Center one half hour in advance of the scheduled runs.
2. Messengers are limited and cannot be used for any purpose other than official courier service.
