To : See Distribution.

1. The following paraphrased radio received from the Chief Administrative Officer, Allied Armies in Italy, is published for the information and compliance of all concerned:

The expression "Zero Hour" will be changed to "H" hours effective from 0100 (Zone B Time) 1 May 1944. This expression will be used exclusively. Unless context is clear all figures shown in conjunction with "H" hours will be followed by either hours or minutes, i.e., H minus 5 hours, H plus 4 minutes. Above system will be adopted by all forces of this command effective at date and hour to be notified. New term has been agreed for use by air ministry and will conform with that already in use by SHAFF and RN.
