3. All other questions affecting the Italian Armed Forces which affect the Army Sub Commission will be referred in the first instance to Main HQ, Army Sub Commission, ACC (Lequile).

2. Each Regional Commissioner herein appointed a liaison officer may designate a member of his staff to perform liaison duties on his behalf. Responsibility therefor will, however, remain with the Regional Commissioner.

3. In the interest of orderly approach to the commands concerned, it is desired that the various elements of the Commission make maximum use of these liaison officers. However, after original contact has been effected through the appropriate liaison officer, subsequent business in connection with the same subject matter may be conducted directly between officers of Headquarters, A.C.C. and the Regions, and the officers of the military formations concerned, provided the liaison officer is informed and agrees.

4. Unreasonable multiplicity of contacts with, and applications to, the Port Commander, Port of Naples, by officers of this headquarters and the regions, has made it necessary to designate one officer to deal with such matters. Accordingly, all business of this headquarters and the regions with Port of Naples authorities, as such, will be conducted exclusively through Major Rolmer. Port matters requiring the attention of the Commanding General, Peninsular Base Section of matters of his staff other than the Port Commander, will be handled through Lt. Col. Bowman.

5. Lt. Col. Alfred C. Bowman is announced as Chief, Liaison Division, Civil Affairs Branch. He will be assisted at this headquarters by Major Charles P. Murchie (B).
