S.C.O's, Fifth and Sixth Armies.

1. All motor vehicles belonging to members of the diplomatic Corps accredited to the Holy See and the papal nuncio carry standard circulation permits overprinted with the letters "CD". The permits are issued by the Ministry of Communications.

2. Diplomatic vehicles also carry special type identification plates, showing the letters "CD" and a number. The plates are rectangular in shape, measuring 320 mm. by 220 mm. The letters and figures appear white on a black surface, and arranged with the letters above the figures as indicated below :-

2. Such personnel are in possession of UNRRA green-bound Certificate of Identity issued in WASHINGTON by the Director General UNRRA. This Certificate will contain an indorsement as follows:

"Valid as an Identity Document in the Mediterranean Theater of Operations"

5. Attention is drawn to the fact that this Certificate of Identity is not a passport, pass or permit, and does not confer any special privileges, unless further indorsed by appropriate authorities.

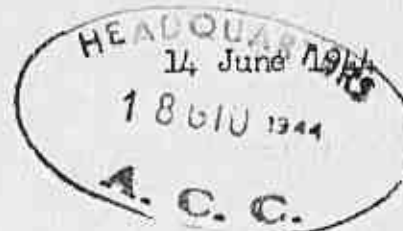

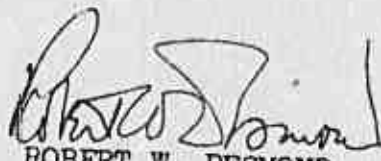
