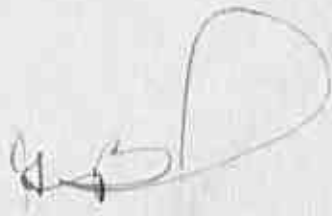

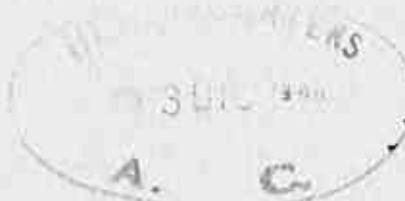

1. This office has been issuing curfew passes to both British and American officers of the various sub-commissions, sections, and branches of this headquarters upon written request from the responsible head or deputy of the sub-commission, section, or branches concerned.

2. These curfew passes have been heretofore obtained from the American Provost Marshal, Rome Area Allied Command. Bulk issues of passes were obtained in the following amounts as shown below.

<u>Dates Requested</u>	<u>Amounts</u>
25 July 1944	200
2 August 1944	150
30 August 1944	98

3. Due to the increased turn over of officers of the commission and the fact that officers leaving the commission for duty in other assignments, passes held by these officers were never turned in.

4. On 11 November 1944 the undersigned submitted a further request to the Provost Marshal, RAAC, for an additional 150 curfew passes so that issues could be made upon application by the various sub-commissions. This request was refused by the Provost Marshal, RAAC, stating that he must have the names of the personnel to whom the passes were to be issued. This department has no way of knowing the names of the officers who will request these passes due to the fact that passes are requested for these officers as they become assigned to this headquarters.

5. This resulted in a telephone conversation between the undersigned and the office of the Provost Marshal, RAAC. Final decision was that this headquarters must furnish the names of the officers for whom the passes were to be issued and further that the Provost Marshal, RAAC, would issue curfew passes only to American military personnel. British personnel are to obtain their curfew passes from their next higher headquarters.

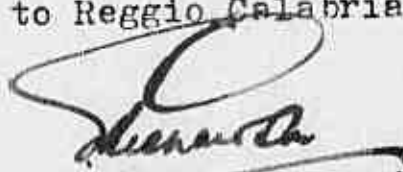
