SUBJECT: Return of Officer Candidate School Applicants to United States.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Qualified warrant Officers and enlisted men selected for rotation under current policies will be encouraged to apply for Officer Candidate School. Needs are substantially greater in Infantry, therefore preference should be given to that arm.

2. Personnel desiring to apply will make application as specified in AR 625-5 dated 12 September 1944. Officer Candidate Schools now in operation for which applications may be submitted are listed in Section IX, Circular Number 367, War Department, 9 September 1944.

3. Units commanded by a General Officer, or the normal command of a General Officer, are authorized to appoint necessary examining boards. Other units will make request to this headquarters for appointment of examining boards.

4. Until made available by this headquarters, the Officer Candidate Test 1 or 2 is not required.

5. Applicants found qualified for attendance at Officer Candidate Schools will be removed from the rotation list and necessary substitutions made.

6. In order to obviate unnecessary correspondence and delay, applications and forwarding instructions will be thoroughly checked to insure correctness of full name, rank and serial number, as well as strict compliance with Paragraph 17 a and b, Section VII, AR 625-5.

7. All papers will be forwarded expeditiously to this headquarters in order that report may be made to the War Department and authorization for return to the United States granted without undue delay.

8. The policy indicated above does not apply to the Women's Army Corps.

SUBJECT: Waiver of Physical Disabilities in Connection with Combat Appointments.

TO : All Concerned.

1. The War Department has advised that the following change has been made in AR 605-10, dated 26 May 1944, in order to permit appointment of individuals who have been disabled in combat, subsequent to being recommended for combat appointment:

(a) Paragraph 22 has been renumbered as 22a and paragraph 22b has been added as follows:

"22b. Overseas Commanders specifically authorized to appoint as 2d Lieutenants in the Army of the United States Warrant Officers and Enlisted Men who have demonstrated their fitness for appointment in actual combat and are qualified therefor, are authorized to waive physical disabilities incurred in combat subsequent to the initiation of the recommendation for appointment, provided the recommendation had been made or approved by a General Officer prior to the time the individual was disabled and that the individual was physically qualified for appointment at that time."

2. In the event that an individual, who has been transferred to a Detachment of Patients as a result of wounds received in action, is tendered a combat appointment, the Commander empowered to make the appointment will advise the hospital concerned and request that action be taken to place the individual on Active Duty as an officer. The commanding officer of the hospital concerned will accomplish the discharge of the individual as a Warrant Officer, Flight Officer or Enlisted Man and issue orders ordering him on Active Duty as a member of the Detachment of Patients in commissioned grade. The Oath of Office and Entry on Active Duty Report, Active Duty Orders, Report of Physical Examination and WD AGO Form No 11 accomplished at the hospital will be forwarded to the appointing authority for inclusion with appointment papers to be forwarded to the War Department through this headquarters.

SUBJECT: Non-Combat Appointments of Second Lieutenants in the Medical Administrative Corps.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Due to the present shortage of Medical Administrative Corps officers in this theater, the Theater Commander has been authorized to appoint qualified warrant officers and enlisted men as second lieutenants in the Army of the United States for duty as Medical Administrative Corps officers. This authority has been granted in order that the requirements of War Department Circular Number 327, 1944 and other changes in Tables of Organization for Medical Corps installations may be fulfilled in this theater.

2. This headquarters will make appointments under this authority until 15 January 1945 to fill authorized Table of Organization or Allotment vacancies. The fact that Table of Organization vacancies do not exist in certain units does not prohibit qualified individuals of those units from submitting applications. In all cases, appropriate assignments will be determined by this headquarters at such time as the candidates are commissioned following approval of appointments by this headquarters.

3. Limitations--Appointments under this authority are limited to warrant officers who are assigned to duty with Medical Department installations and Medical Department enlisted men in this theater. Applications for appointment of other qualified individuals and recommendations for appointment of Women's Army Corps personnel in the Medical Administrative Corps will be forwarded to this headquarters for consideration and submission to the War Department if warranted.

4. Authority for Submission of Application--This letter will be cited as authority for submission of applications to this headquarters for appointment of Medical Administrative Corps officers. Candidates will be selected and recommendations submitted in accordance with the provisions of MATCUSA Circular 49, 1944, except that for the purpose of these appointments the last sentence of paragraph 2, and paragraph 3d, Section I, insofar as they pertain to restriction on appointments for assignment to the Medical Department, are not applicable.

5. Qualifications--In addition to the minimum standards for qualifications indicated in paragraph 3b, Section I, MATCUSA Circular 49, the following educational and experience qualifications, while not essential, are desirable for appointment in the Medical Administrative Corps:

- a. Successful completion of 1 year of college.
- b. Practical experience in positions entailing the handling of men, such as the head of a department or section of a business concern, teacher, coach of an athletic team, noncommissioned grade.
- c. At least 1 year's experience in business or industry in a position as accountant, supervisor of records, sales manager, etc.
- d. Practical experience in hospital management, maintenance of hospital records, medical supply accounts, mass management of large institutions, practical experience in pharmacy.

6. Records-The membership of Boards appointed to examine applicants for appointment in the Medical Administrative Corps will include at least one officer of the Medical Administrative Corps or Pharmacy Corps, in field grade.

7. The following information and statements will be furnished in connection with applications submitted for appointment:

- a. Indication that applicant understands that appointment will preclude rotation to the United States, for other than health reasons, for one year from date of appointment.
- b. Statements as to applicant's leadership ability, character and efficiency ratings.
- c. Statement that applicant has served overseas for a minimum period of six months, including a brief synopsis of service or verification of service shown under item 9a, WD AGO Form No 0830.
- d. Statement as to prospective value to the service in future assignments and higher grade.
- e. Statement as to whether a vacancy exists.
- f. Certification of AGCT score.
- g. Title of position held in present assignment and title of position for which appointment is recommended.

8. Applications submitted under this authority will be thoroughly checked to insure correctness of full name, rank and serial number, and consistency of information furnished as to education, experience and qualifications. The Report of Physical Examination (WD AGO Form No 63) must be of recent date and signed by at least two medical officers. The Personnel Placement Questionnaire (WD AGO Form No 0850-one copy, and 0850a-two copies) must be properly completed. The mailing address on this form (item 1) will be the applicant's permanent home or legal address rather than a present military address.

1. Section X, Circular No. 333, War Department, dated 15 August 1944 and amendment thereto, Section VI, Circular No. 370, War Department, 12 September 1944 are published below for the information, guidance and compliance of all concerned:

a. War Department Circular No 333, as:

VI.-SANITARY CORPS.--1. The Sanitary Corps, Army of the United States, has been authorized an additional procurement objective, and is desirous of making the opportunity for appointment as second lieutenant available to as many qualified enlisted men as possible.

2. This Corps is made up of commissioned officers who are non-medical graduates. A need now exists for men qualified in any of the following specialities: sanitary engineering, medical entomology, medical bacteriology, serology, biological chemistry, parasitology, or industrial hygiene engineering.

3. Minimum requirements are:

a. Educational.

- (1) Bachelor's degree with an appropriate science major from an approved college or university.
- (2) Advanced degree of M.S. or Ph. D. will be given consideration if the applicant does not have sufficient experience qualifications.

b. Experience.

See letterfile same as above dated 25 Oct.

- (1) A minimum of 2 years of appropriate experience obtained in the particular field in which the applicant is qualified and while in the employ of a State, county, or city; a hospital approved by the American Medical Association; an approved college or university; or approved private agency.

- (2) In exceptional instances, in lieu of the experience

qualifications listed in (1) above, and upon the specific recommendation of their commanding officers, bacteriologists, biochemists, serologists, and parasitologists may be considered for a commission upon the completion of 1 year of Army laboratory experience.

4. Enlisted men who possess the requirements outlined in paragraph 3 may apply for an appointment in the Army of the United States for assignment in the Sanitary Corps. Applications will be submitted in accordance with section II, Circular No. 186, War Department, 1943, and will be forwarded to the director of the officer procurement branch of the service command in which the applicant is stationed instead of to the nearest district office of the Officer Procurement Service. The references to AR 605-10 in Section II, Circular No. 186, War Department, 1943, will be considered to refer to paragraphs 7 and 10 AR 605-10, 26 May 1944.

5. Sanitary Corps officers have been placed in a scarce category by the Secretary of War.

6. This information will be given publicity throughout all commands.

7. War Department Memorandum No. W605-21-43, 11 May 1943, pertaining to the foregoing subject, is rescinded."

"VI—SANITARY CORPS.—1. Provisions of section X, Circular No. 333, War Department, 1944, so far as they pertain to bacteriologists, biochemists, and serologists, apply to enlisted women of the Women's Army Corps. Such personnel may be appointed second lieutenants in the Women's Army Corps for assignment and immediate detail in the Sanitary Corps. The provisions of paragraph 7b(1), c, and d, and paragraph 10a(2) (b), (c), and (d), AR 605-10, 26 May 1944, are not applicable. Officers appointed under this authority who later prove unsatisfactory are subject to the provisions of AR 605-230. They may be reassigned within the Medical Department. Under no condition will officers so appointed be reassigned outside the Medical Department.

2. This information will be given publicity throughout all commands in which enlisted women are serving."

2. Applications for appointment in the Sanitary Corps will be submitted in accordance with Section I, Circular No. 363, War Department, 7 September 1944. The provisions of paragraphs 7 and 10, AR 605-10, 26 May 1944 will apply as to basic requirements and submission of applications, except for such sub-paragraphs which are indicated in Section VI, War Department Circular 370, as not applicable.

3. In order to obviate unnecessary correspondence, applications will be thoroughly checked by unit commanders to insure correctness of full name, rank and serial number, and completeness of information furnished as to education

1. Section II, War Department Circular Number 592, dated 2 October 1944, is published below for the information, guidance and compliance of all concerned.

"II - APPOINTMENT

1. The Adjutant General has been authorized a procurement objective for the appointment as second lieutenants, Army of the United States, of enlisted men who are qualified as clinical psychologists. It is desired to make this opportunity for appointment available to as many qualified enlisted men as possible.

2. The minimum requirements are:

a. Educational. Must have, as a minimum, a bachelor's degree in psychology, educational psychology, industrial psychology, or sociology. A master's or doctor's degree, or the equivalent in academic credits, in one of these fields is desirable. (A master's or doctor's degree in one of these fields is acceptable even though the bachelor's degree is in a different subject.) Graduate studies under ASTP in any of the subjects listed in b (4) below will be accepted as the equivalent of no more than 1 year of graduate work.

b. Experience.

- (1) For applicants having a doctor's degree. -- At least 1 year of experience in clinical psychology as a civilian or 1 year of enlisted experience as Psychiatric Social Worker (263), Classification Specialist (275), Personnel Consultant Assistant (289), or Personnel Technician (290).
- (2) For applicants having a master's degree. -- At least 3 years of experience in clinical psychology as a civilian or 1 year of such experience and 1 year of enlisted experience as Psychiatric Social Worker (263), Classification Specialist (275), Personnel Consultant (289), or Personnel Technician (290).

- (3) For applicants having a bachelor's degree. -- At least 3 years of experience in clinical psychology as a civilian or 2 years of such experience and 1 year of enlisted experience as Psychiatric Social Worker (263), Classification Specialist (275), Personnel Consultant (289), or Personnel Technician (290).
- (4) Clinical psychology is interpreted to mean psychological work involving direct contact with individuals or in investigation of individual behavior, adult or child. Such experience should include practice in the interpretation of test data as an aid in the diagnosis of mental illness. Desirable experience includes psychological testing, counseling, guidance, mental hygiene, or assembly and analysis of case histories in any of the following fields: Welfare; personnel, institutional (Prisons and hospitals, etc.), care of the mentally or physically handicapped, or teaching of psychology at college level. This need not have been paid experience, and pro rata credit will be allowed for part-time work, or experience acquired concurrently with graduate study.

3. Applications are desired from enlisted men who possess the requirements outlined in paragraph 2 for a pointment in the Army of the United States for this assignment. Applications will be submitted in accordance with Section I, Circular Number 363, War Department, 1944.

4. This information will be given publicity throughout all commands.

War Department Memo 350-44, dated 26 September 1944, is quoted below for the information of all concerned:

APPOINTMENTS TO CADETSHIPS IN UNITED STATES COAST GUARD ACADEMY:

At the request of the Commandant United States Coast Guard, it is desired that the following information be made available to all enlisted men:

On 9 to 10 May 1945, the annual competitive examination for appointments to cadetships in the United States Coast Guard Academy will be conducted throughout the country.

The Academy, which is located at New London, Connecticut, is a fully accredited educational institution operating under the same high scholastic and military standards as the United States Naval and the United States Military Academies, conducted by the Coast Guard for the professional training of young men who are candidates for commissions and careers in the Coast Guard. Successful completion of the 4-year course, which is basically scientific in character, leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering and a commission in the regular Coast Guard.

Appointments to cadetships are offered to young men standing highest in the nationwide competitive examination. The standing of a candidate is determined by averaging his grades in the mathematics and English examinations together with his adaptability grade. The adaptability grade is assigned by the selection board on the basis of a personal interview, the applicant's educational and experience background, and the records submitted with his application.

All men who meet the following basic requirements are eligible to compete in the Academy examination to be held on 9 to 10 May 1945:

Completed applications must be postmarked not later than 1 April 1945.

No waiver of the requirements will be granted.

Candidates who are successful in obtaining an appointment to the Coast Guard Academy may be discharged from the Army to accept the appointment."

The Board is authorized to deal directly with the Commanding General, Fifth Army, the Commanding General, Rome Area Command, the Commanding General, MAAF, and such other commands as may be necessary to secure essential witnesses and evidence. All movements of the Board and its members into and within Rome will be coordinated by the Commanding General, Fifth Army, who is requested to facilitate the activities of Board to the greatest extent practicable.

3. Evidence will be as comprehensive as the requirements for expeditious completion of the inventory report permits. The gist of all pertinent testimony will be recorded, and all pertinent documents and written records will be incorporated in the record of proceedings. It is stressed that photographs, sketches and diagrams are of great assistance in securing clarity of understanding. Ten complete copies of the report of proceedings will be furnished CG Headquarters, Allied Armies in Italy.

4. If in the opinion of the Board a partial or preliminary report of the findings of the Board is desirable such a report will be rendered.

5. The report is intended to cover damage, whether direct or indirect due to aerial bombardment to non-military objectives. If there is doubt as to where damage is due to aerial bombardment or as to whether the objective was a true military one the report will include such cases in the inventory with proper explanatory remarks.

6. The report of inventory will contain no findings of praise or criticism of bombing or other military action and no recommendation as to repair or rehabilitation of any damaged objectives. Any military lessons learned from the survey or any conclusions reached by individual members of the Board may be transmitted by those individual members to their respective commanders for such separate action as may be desirable.
