SUBJECT: Return of Recipients of the Medal of Honor to United States.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Letter, this headquarters, file AG 210.3/598 A-0, dated 27 June 1944, subject as above, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

2. Upon receipt of this letter, personnel whose recommendation for the award of the Medal of Honor has been approved by an Army Commander, may be sent by that commander to a rest camp or other appropriate place on temporary duty, in cases where such action is deemed advisable. It should be clearly explained to the individual that he is to be immediately available for the presentation by the Theater or Army Commander upon receipt of approval of the award by the War Department.

3. After presentation, and provided the individual agrees, orders will be issued by the Army Commander accomplishing the transfer of the recipient to a Replacement Depot for transshipment to the United States, citing this letter as authority therefor, and notifying by most expeditious means the Commanding General, Replacement Command and this headquarters of the action taken. In the event of notification of disapproval of the Medal of Honor, or if a lesser award is authorized by the War Department, the Army Commander will direct return of the individual to duty.

4. The Commanding General, Replacement Command, is responsible for promptly furnishing this headquarters the following information in order that necessary orders may be issued with provision for air travel, publicity and reception in the United States:

a. That he has verified the fact that presentation has been accomplished.

b. That the individual has arrived at an installation of his command and whether he wishes to return to the United States by normal rotation or temporary duty and subsequent return to his unit.

c. In the event that the recipient is an enlisted man, the name of the escort officer accompanying him, preferably a junior officer from the recipient's state who is awaiting rotation at an installation of the Replacement Command.

Para 10 - Quarterly Returns Sub-para (a) (b) and (c) are cancelled and the following substituted:-

(a) A consolidated quarterly return on the proforma Appendix "A" hereto will be rendered in duplicate to this H.Q., so as to arrive on 1 January, April, July and October through the usual channels as prescribed in para 4 above. In the case of H.Q., A.C.C. the return will be prepared by the initiating officer named in Col (c) of Appendix "B" hereto which gives the channels to be observed within this H.Q.

SUBJECT: Unit Personnel Requisition for Medical Department Officers

TO : All Concerned

HEADQUARTERS
APO 534
ACC

1. Reference is made to Section IV, NATOUSA Circular No. 85, 1944.
2. Effective upon receipt of this directive, all Unit Personnel Requisitions for Medical Department Officer Personnel will follow normal command channels to the major commander concerned who will forward them to the Commanding General, Replacement Command, NATOUSA.
3. In preparation and submission of the requisition, the following instructions will govern:

a. Action by the Requisitioning Unit:

- (1) Separate requisitions for Medical Department Officer replacements will be prepared and submitted immediately upon receipt of official notification that the loss of a Medical Department Officer constitutes a permanent loss; e.g., died, missing in action, reassigned to another position vacancy without replacement, transferred to a Detachment of Patients or, in the case of combat units, has been classified as Class B (Those immediately fit for other than general military service).
- (2) Requisitions will be submitted for officers of the same rank as the officer who constituted the loss.
- (3) Specification Serial Numbers for Medical Department Officers will be supplemented by a brief statement of the specialty field in which the officer should be trained, or a statement of the general requirements of the duties to which the officer will be assigned.
- (4) Recommendations for promotion will not be initiated to fill the vacancy created until a replacement has been received. Officers will not be furnished to fill requisitions with rank as the primary basis of assignment, but in all instances will be assigned on the basis of professional capacity for the duty requirement.

b. Action by Intermediate commander:

- (1) Upon receipt of a requisition by the aforementioned commanders, provided there is no surplus personnel within the command who can be reassigned to the requisitioning unit, the requisition will be forwarded to the Commanding General, Replacement Command, NATOUSA. In this instance, no assignment will be made to the requisitioning unit, but if indicated will be augmented by personnel on temporary duty.

(2) Provided competent surplus personnel exists within the command, reassignment will be made and the requisition returned to the unit.

c. Action by Commanding General, Replacement Command, NATOUSA.

(1) Upon receipt of the requisition at Headquarters Replacement Command, NATOUSA it will be sent directly to the Surgeon, this headquarters, for nomination of individuals qualified for the particular position vacancy and establishment of priority.

4. All requisitions for Medical Department personnel submitted prior to 15 July 1944 are hereby cancelled.

1. It is most urgently requested that early and earnest consideration be given to the assignment of one additional officer to the Adjutant's Department, for duty in the Miscellaneous Section.

2. The services of an additional officer are very badly needed, for the following reasons:

a. The Miscellaneous Section, which is responsible for the handling of all incoming correspondence and signals, is now superintended largely by a Warrant Officer Class I (B). Prior to the establishment of the Adjutant's Department, during the period when parallel activities were performed by the Adjutant General's Section, a commissioned officer was available, full-time, in charge of this Section. Since that time, the volume of work in the Section has increased very materially, and the available supervision, at this time, is only that of the Adjutant, who has a number of other duties to perform.

b. With the increasing complexity of the work of the Commission, and with the increased volume of correspondence and signal traffic processed through the Miscellaneous Section, it becomes imperative to have a commissioned officer in full charge of this work, in order that the Warrant Officer and non-commissioned personnel may devote full time to their work proper, and not be required to exercise the type of supervision normally assigned to an officer.

c. Additionally, the personnel now on duty in the Miscellaneous Section are somewhat handicapped in dealing with higher ranking officers by reason of the fact that there is no officer on duty in the Section.

3. It has come to the attention of the undersigned that 2d Lt ANTHONY SCARIANO, 01004230, AUS, is now available for assignment within this Headquarters. This officer is known to the undersigned, has a broad administrative background, is a graduate of the Army Administration School (Adjutant General's School), and is, in the opinion of the undersigned, eminently well-fitted for assignment to the Miscellaneous Section, Adjutant's Department.

MEMORANDUM TO: Vice President, Administrative Section,
Vice President, Economic Section.

1. Request that you instruct Directors of Sub-commissions to refrain from informing Regions that transfers of their specialist personnel "have been arranged." Several recent incidents have occurred in which the Directors of Sub-commissions have so informed Regions and the transfers were impossible for reasons unknown to the Sub-commission. Since demands for personnel are received from many sources both from inside and outside ACC, it is impossible to keep Directors informed of all contemplated plans for the use of all personnel. In many cases, these plans are changed for good reason within the day or hour. Further, the internal organization of forward Regions, such as IV and V are many times unknown to Directors and disruption of Provincial teams is quite likely to be caused without intending it. To give notice of changes which later can not be made or without consultation with any HQ which may be involved, gives rise to confusion and irritation.

2. Consultation with SCs and SCAGs reference their personnel problems is within the province of Directors and is to be encouraged. Possible transfers may be discussed but no promises should be made in reference thereto.

3. All requests for transfers, attachments or temporary duty of specialist officers should be processed through the Establishment Officer, or the Executive Officer (B) who is responsible for all personnel placements (not directly to G-1). In all cases of disagreement between SCs and Directors of Sub-commissions as to the assignment or relief of a specialist officer, the situation will be presented to the Establishment Officer for decision. Co-operation of Directors will be very much appreciated.
