The names of the above Officer, Warrant Officer and men of a Medium Regiment, Royal Artillery in action on 30 Jul 44 in an area known to be mined, have been brought to the

notice of the Commander-in-Chief for outstanding gallantry and self-sacrifice in unhesitatingly entering a minefield to the assistance of their wounded comrades.

The Commander-in-Chief congratulates Lt. WAKELIN, BSM DAVIES, Gnr JESSOP, Gnr McALLISTER, Gnr GOODALL, Gnr WATERS and Gnr PALMER on their very gallant conduct and directs that these acts of gallantry be recorded on the officer's AF B192A and in the case of the OR on their conduct sheets in accordance with King's Regulations para 1718(b) (xvii).

286. Transit Facilities

1. Cases are frequently occurring of Officers and OR being despatched to units by a route which necessitates their staging in places where no organised transit facilities exist.

As a consequence, considerable and unnecessary discomfort is caused to individuals; also the resources of small units in such places may be severely strained in an endeavour to stage transient personnel.

2. All units will, when despatching personnel to another location, ensure that either

(a) the personnel can reach their final destination without intermediate staging, or

(b) where staging is necessary, personnel are routed via places where staging facilities are known to exist.

3. Sub-Area, Area etc., HQ should, if necessary, be consulted as to availability of transit facilities en route before personnel are despatched.

3. The Camps and Hotels referred to in AAI RO 143 of 1944 are no longer at the disposal of HQ, AAI.

4. Bulk allotment of vacancies in AAI Rest Camps and Hotels is made by HQ, AAI to Armies and Districts.

5. Special attention is directed to the joining instructions published as Appendix "A" to AAI RO 143 of 1944. In many cases these instructions are not being complied with, resulting in much unnecessary work to the Camp staffs and inconvenience to the men on leave at the Camps.

6. "50" "A" and "B" rest Camp staffs have been disbanded and reformed into staffs with different designations, including the two mentioned in para 1 above.

7. Attention is also directed to AAI RO 288 of 1944 in connection with leave generally.

287. Rest Camps

Reference AAI RO 143 of 1944.

1. The AAI Rest Camps now consist of the following:—

(a) ROME Rest Camp ("R" Rest Camp).

(b) FLORENCE Rest Camp ("U" Rest Camp—to be opened shortly).

2. There is an Officers' Rest Hotel at the SAVOIA Hotel, FLORENCE,

288. Leave in AAI

1. So far as accommodation permits, a period of six clear days leave, exclusive of travelling time, may be given to each officer and OR in AAI, not more often than once in six months.

2. Leave outside ITALY is not permitted, except as stated in paras 3 and 4 below.

3. No officer or OR will be sent on leave unless accommodation has been arranged for him in an authorised Rest

Camp, Centre or Hotel, or in the case of Women's Services, in an approved Hostel.

4. Accommodation in Rest Camps, Centres and Hotels is allotted to formations, and sub-allotted to lower formations and units. It is not available to individuals who have not been allotted vacancies. Arrangements at Women's Services Hostels may be made direct between the unit and Hostel, except where special rules are laid down.

5. Every officer and OR on leave will be in possession of a proper pass showing his number, rank, name and unit, the period of his leave, and the accommodation in which he is to stay.

6. Joining instructions for AAI Rest Camps and Hotels are given in AAI RO 143 of 1944.

7. Rest Centres to provide short rest from the line may be established by formations, not below Corps, at the discretion of Armies within their areas. Such Centres will be closed as soon as the Army rear boundary moves forward of them unless the consent of AAI is obtained to their remaining open.

8. Day leave may be given at the discretion of unit commanders, but restrictions on entry into particular towns and localities must be strictly observed.

9. Leave to the UK, even on compassionate grounds, is not yet open. The grant of compassionate leave elsewhere to certain classes of personnel is authorized in AFHQ GRO 572 of 1944. Applications for such leave will be submitted in the same way as is laid down in AFHQ GRO 546 of 1944 for applications for compassionate posting.

10. Nothing in this order affects special forms of leave which are the subject of separate orders.

289. Instructions Regarding the Employment of Civilian Labour (ITALY and SICILY)

Reference AAI RO 227 of 1944.

In all cases where chauffeurs and drivers are being paid at the higher rate of 80-110 lire per day, these employees will be given one week's notice forthwith and where necessary, re-employed at the lower and correct rate, 70-90 lire per day.

290. Blankets

1. There is a shortage of blankets throughout the world and it is unlikely that the total number of blankets due to this theatre this year will be shipped.

2. Numerous cases are reported by the Army Equipment Inspectorate of blankets being used for tablecloths, curtains, and other purposes for which they are not intended. If this misuse continues, it will not be possible to implement in all units in this theatre the full winter scale of four per man.

3. O&C units will take immediate action to stop the misuse of blankets and disciplinary action will be taken against offenders in future. Any surplus blankets held will be returned forthwith to Ordnance.
