Unauthorized leave in Rome will not be tolerated. insure that enlisted personnel of their commands are not granted leave to visit Rome except within the authorized allotments at recognized United States Army and Army Air Force Leave Centers or in cases where arrangements have previously been made with A.C. of S., G-1, Rome Area, MTOUSA.

2. The provisions of the foregoing paragraph are not intended to prohibit the granting of day leave privileges to enlisted personnel for the purpose of visiting Rome where such personnel return to their units on the same day of their visit.

Reference Two HQ AAI letter 5010/CAO dated 24 Jul 44 (not Adv all addressees).

1. With effect from 1 Aug 44, day leave allotment to Eighth Army causes and future allotments to units and formations are being made directly by this HQ and no longer by HQ AAI.

2. The following principles will govern day leave in ROME:-

(a) Day leave in ROME will only be given to troops stationed within 30 miles of ROME.

(b) Day leave for troops stationed within 30 miles of ROME will be restricted to 5% of unit strength except in the case of large units or formations who are in transit and for whom special arrangements will be made on direct application to G-1 ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND.

3. 1 District, 3 District and HQ British Troops ANZIO are requested to submit a return to this HQ giving a list of units under their administration who are located within 30 miles of ROME, stating the number of day leave passes they intend to issue on the 5% basis.

Units under direct administrative command of this HQ may issue day leave passes based on 5% of their strength as rendered to this HQ on the weekly G-1 strength return.

4. Units within 30 miles of ROME will issue troops on day leave with a pass in the form of the specimen attached, which will be the only form of pass for British troops on day leave which will be accepted by the military police and for the issue of meal tickets.

5. Meal tickets for day leave personnel will be distributed at the British Day Leave Car park (Information Tent) near the Circus Maximus, on production by the soldier of his day leave pass which MUST be in the standard form as shown on attached specimen. Meal tickets will be distributed on this system beginning FRIDAY 4 AUG 44.

6. All ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND Routine Orders and General Orders are applicable to troops on day leave and the privilege of day leave may be withdrawn from any unit whose members do not keep up the high standard of discipline.

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(a) Day leave in ROME will only be given to troops stationed within 30 miles of ROME.

(b) Day leave for troops stationed within 30 miles of ROME will be restricted to 5% of unit strength except in the case of large units or formations who are in transit and for whom special arrangements will be made on direct application to G-1 ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND.

3. 1 District, 3 District and HQ British Troops ANZIO are requested to submit a return to this HQ giving a list of units under their administration who are located within 30 miles of ROME, stating the number of day leave passes they intend to issue on the 5% basis.

Units under direct administrative command of this HQ may issue day leave passes based on 5% of their strength as rendered to this HQ on the weekly G-1 strength return.

4. Units within 30 miles of ROME will issue troops on day leave with a pass in the form of the specimen attached, which will be the only form of pass for British troops on day leave which will be accepted by the military police and for the issue of meal tickets.

5. Meal tickets for day leave personnel will be distributed at the British Day Leave Car Park (Information Tent) near the Circus Maximus, on production by the soldier of his day leave pass which MUST be in the standard form as shown on attached specimen. Meal tickets will be distributed on this system beginning FRIDAY 4 AUG 44.

6. All ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND routine Orders and General Orders are applicable to troops on day leave and the privilege of day leave may be withdrawn from any unit whose members do not keep up the high standard of discipline and turnout required in ROME.

SUBJECT: Day Leave Permits.

TO : See Distribution.

1. Pursuant to Letter, Headquarters, AFI, File 5610/CAO, 24 July 44, there will be no day leave permits issued except to troops located within a 30 mile radius of Rome.
2. Day leave for troops stationed within 30 miles of Rome will be restricted to 5% of unit strength except in the case of large units who are in transit and for whom special arrangements will be made at least 24 hours in advance with G-1, Rome Allied Area Command. (Phone Duplex 1)
3. All directives from this headquarters pertaining to uniform, weapons, discipline, and curfew hours will be strictly adhered to. See Stars and Stripes for locations of restaurants and meal schedules.
4. All ranks visiting Rome on day leave will arrive not earlier than 0700 hours and will leave the city by 2000 hours.
5. In order to prevent congestion of city traffic, vehicles carrying troops on day leave will park at the Day Leave Parking Area only. This is located near the United Men's and Women's Club in the Borgosesia Gardens (coordinates: 743-603, Town Plan of Rome Scale 1:12,000)
