Memo for Col Pickard:

1. I should appreciate your giving a little thought to the following line of thought, inasmuch as, if practicable, I should like to put it into effect shortly after the headquarters moves up here. I have not as yet discussed it with Colonel Clough, or with any of the powers that be, but I daresay that there will be no strenuous objection on their part.

2. In sum, the proposition is this: a substantial amount of mail and signal traffic comes into the office after six o'clock in the evening every day. This accumulates, more or less (the signals, of course, are typed up by the early cable typist), and descends on the Miscellaneous section every morning.

3. In order to combat this situation, to prepare all this traffic for immediate distribution as soon as the office opens, I propose to install a "late shift" consisting roughly of the following personnel:

- a. One Distribution Clerk.
- b. One Registry Clerk.
- c. One Cable Typist.
- d. (possibly) one clerk in Message Centre.

4. I do not propose to do this with the existing personnel that we have, all of whom, as you and I know, are sadly overworked. However, I do think that we can "salvage" from the Salerno people sufficient personnel for this.

5. Hours that I have in mind would be (at the present writing) from 1600 to 2400.

6. I rather think that this might provide a generous step in the direction of solving the early-morning load, and at the same time make a good deal of the present night work unnecessary.

7. I should like to have your reaction to the proposal generally, with points in favor and against, also your views on the proposed hours and the personnel requirements I have outlined.

SUBJECT: Request for change in assignment.

TO : Commanding Officer, Co "L", 2675th Regt, ACC, APO 394.

1. I respectfully request a transfer in assignment from the Adjutant, ACC to Black Market Investigation headed by Lt LIBSIUS. I have been interviewed by Capt CORREA who has now been transferred, and he indicated that my services as a lawyer would be most welcomed in that department.

2. In civilian life, I was an active practicing attorney for approximately twelve years and I maintained my own office at 745 Fifth Avenue, New York City. I believe that with this background I could be most useful in the above stated type of work.

3. 1. In order to continue adequately the operation of this department, it is imperative that three (3) additional enlisted men, all clerk-typists, be assigned to this department.

2. There is also a distinct possibility that this department may be required to commence the handling of communications in this Headquarters in the manner in effect until approximately November 15, 1943, i.e., the complete registration of all documents which pass through. Should this be the case, additional personnel requirements will be eight (8) clerks-general. Additional space will also be required of a minimum of 250 square feet.
