Memo for JAM Pickens:

1. I should appreciate your giving a little thought to the following line of thought, inasmuch as, if practicable, I should like to put it into effect shortly after the headquarters moves up here. I have not as yet discussed it with Colonel Clough, or with any of the powers that be, but I dare say that there will be no strenuous objection on their part.

2. In sum, the proposition is this: a substantial amount of mail and signal traffic comes into the office after six o'clock in the evening every day. This accumulates, more or less (the signals, of course, are typed up by the early cable typist), and descends on the Miscellaneous Section every morning.

3. In order to combat this situation, to prepare and this traffic for immediate distribution as soon as the office opens, I propose to install a "late shift" consisting roughly of the following personnel:

- a. One Distribution Clerk.
- b. One Registry Clerk.
- c. One Cable Typist.
- d. (possibly) one clerk in Message Centre.

4. I do not propose to do this with the existing personnel that we have, all of whom, as you and I know, are sadly overworked. However, I do think that we can "salvage" from the Salerno people sufficient personnel for this.

5. Hours that I have in mind would be (at the present writing) from 1600 to 2400.

6. I rather think that this might provide a generous step in the direction of solving the early-morning load, and at the same time make a good deal of the present night work unnecessary.

7. I should like to have your reaction to the proposal generally, with points in favor and against, also your views on the proposed hours and the personnel requirements I have outlined.

SUBJECT: Request for change in assignment.

TO : Commanding Officer, Co "L", 2675th Regt, ACC, APO 394.

1. I respectfully request a transfer in assignment from the Adjutant, ACC to Black Market Investigation headed by Lt LIBSIUS. I have been interviewed by Capt CORREA who has now been transferred, and he indicated that my services as a lawyer would be most welcomed in that department.

2. In civilian life, I was an active practicing attorney for approximately twelve years and I maintained my own office at 745 Fifth Avenue, New York City. I believe that with this background I could be most useful in the above stated type of work.

3. While at Rear Headquarters, I was Personnel Clerk and I was in charge of all Service Records, WD AGO Form 20a, handled all EM allotments, made out all payrolls and vouchers, and was frequently consulted as to personal matters including marital legal problems, powers of attorney, etc. I was finally ordered to turn over these Forms to the Company Clerk by Col. 1. In order to continue adequately the operation of this department, it is imperative that three (3) additional enlisted men, all clerk-typists, be assigned to this department.

2. There is also a distinct possibility that this department may be required to commence the handling of communications in this Headquarters in the manner in effect until approximately November 15, 1943, i.e., the complete registration of all documents which pass through. Should this be the case, additional personnel requirements will be eight (8) clerks-general. Additional space will also be required of a minimum of 250 square feet. These requirements are in addition to those listed in paragraph one above.

1. Further to this H.C. Letter (6895/0-1) dated 18 March '44.
Sub-Commissions and branches of H.C. Allied Control Commission will render returns on ACC Form H.2 and report observations on ACC Form H.3 in respect of British Other Banks to the Detachment (at Naples or Salerno) on whose strength the Other Banks are borne. H.C. Component ACC (Main) and H.C. Component ACC (No. 1) will consolidate such information and forward it, supported in the case of ACC Form H.2 by a nominal roll, to C-1 (British) at this H.C.

This does not apply to Intercom and Displaced Persons Sub-Commission and to Italian Refugee Branch, which will continue to render returns as submitted direct to this H.C.

2. Losses of Other Being

It is the responsibility of Regional and Detachment Commanders to ensure that arrival, departure and British Other Banks both belonging and attached to ACC/ACC are reported to this H.C., with the date of arrival or departure, on ACC Form H.3.

3. Trade Mark

(i) Verification that British Other Bank is entitled to Trade Pay can be made from a study of its H.C. Part I, in which a record of the Trade Pay which he has issued is kept. Where there is any doubt as to his qualification to receive Trade Pay, this H.C. should be notified and application will be made by this H.C. to H.C. and Detachment for confirmation.

(ii) Vehicle Mechanic

Referring to the removal from the list of Army Drivers of Drivers H.V. and Motor Mechanic's names of British O.P.s are being transferred to Vehicle Mechanics. Drivers H.V. and Motor Mechanics who are not transferred as Vehicle Mechanics by 1 July '44 will revert to normal rates of pay.

4. O.P.s returned to hospital from hospital is required should be shown in Part II of ACC Form H.2. Their arrival as a Detachment or Detachment after being discharged from hospital should be reported to this H.C. on ACC Form H.3.
