1. Headquarters Allied Armies in Italy has issued the following instructions regarding day leaves and passes to the City of Rome.

"(a) Day leave (passes) to visit Rome will be given to troops stationed within 30 miles of Rome.

(b) The number of passes which may be authorized in paragraph (a) will not exceed 5% of unit strength.

(c) Armed forces personnel not in possession of the authorized pass will be picked up by the Military Police and the fact reported to proper Commander.

(d) CO's & C will report to HQ A.I. organizations which permit passes to Rome in violation of instructions."

2. Instructions on the policy of this Headquarters relative to visiting Rome were published in paragraph 24, PBS Daily Bulletin 231, 13 August 1944. They are reproduced as follows:

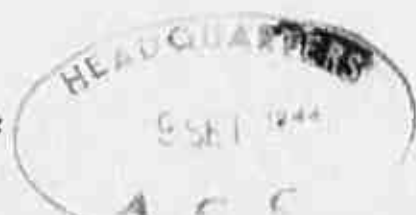
"Passes to Rome. No personnel of units assigned or attached to P.B.S. outside of a 30 mile radius of Rome will be permitted to visit Rome excepting those on official business."

3. It has come to the attention of this headquarters that there has been a general disregard of these instructions by unit commanders and by officers and enlisted personnel. Any further disregard of these instructions by individuals and/or responsible unit commanders will result in disciplinary action.

4. This directive will be read to all personnel at unit formations, and will be posted on all unit bulletin boards.

5. All unit commanders will acknowledge receipt of this directive by 0800 hours 10 September 1944, and will state in the acknowledgment that, (1) they fully understand the provisions of this directive and (2) that the provisions of par 4 have been carried out.
