English sailor, JAMES EDWARD BOUTH C/YS 23446 died whilst in this Unit at 2200 hrs on October 30th 1942 from "enterocolitis carrying diptheria germs". He was buried GROTTAGLIE CEMETERY - special section for Foreign Military.

When admitted he was wearing an Italian uniform and stated he belonged to a party shipwrecked picked up at sea by an Italian hospital ship.
