Reference Area Routine Order No. 228 of 10 October 1944.

1. Para 3 of the above mentioned ARO will be cancelled and the following substituted:

Cash Grants

- (e) The sum of 2d per head may be claimed from Public Funds for all troops of the following categories if subsisted on Field Service Rations:
 - (i) British and Colonial (White) CEs
 - (ii) Members but not Officers of Womens' Services and Organizations entitled to free rations in kind
 - (iii) Naval Ratings or RAF CEs subsisted by the Army
 - (iv) Dominion and Allied personnel attached to British Units for rations (e.g. in hospitals) and not housed separately
 - (v) All troops not included in the above mentioned categories who are subsisted on British Rations and paid at British rates of pay (U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, etc.) (Colonial)
- (b) The sum of 2d per head will be admissible for all native troops irrespective of faith
- (c) Scottish Units may if desired, claim the allowance for New Year's Day instead of Christmas Day
- (d) Non-Christians may receive the appropriate allowance either on Christmas Day or one other feast day during the year
- (e) The sum of 2d per head will be claimed through the Public Account, claims being made on a certificate in duplicate showing the actuality in the name on the day in question.

(a) The sum of 9d per man may be claimed from Public Funds for all troops of the following categories if subsisted on Field Service Rations:

- (i) British and Colonial (White) ORs
 - (ii) Members but not Officers of Women's Services and Organizations entitled to free rations in kind
 - (iii) Naval Ratings or RAF ORs subsisted by the Army
 - (iv) Dominion and Allied personnel attached to British Units for rations (e.g. in hospitals) and not rations separately
 - (v) All troops not included in the above mentioned categories who are subsisted on British Rations and paid a British rate of pay (e.g. A.C. for Coys, etc) (Colonial)
- (b) The sum of 2d per head will be admissible for all native troops irrespective of faith
- (c) Scottish Units may if desired, claim the allowance for New Year's Day instead of Christmas Day
- (d) Non-Christians may receive the appropriate allowance either on Christmas Day or on other feast day during the year
- (e) Sum admissible will be claimed through Paymaster Account, claim being given to a Controller in the appropriate branch of the War Office in the case of the day in question.

2. Under AFHQ/2562/4 (Print) of 16 Dec 44, authority is granted for an issue on repayment (if desired) of the following items to all troops at Christmas:

Atta	4 oz per man
Gai	1 oz per man
Sugar	2 oz per man
Milk	2 oz per man

SUBJECT : Documentation - G.O.P.

Par. No. 5

1. Further to this H.C. Letter 16092/9-1 dated 16 March 1944.

Sub-Committees and members of H.C. Allied Control Commission will render returns on ACC Form B-3 and report completion on ACC Form B-3 in respect of British Other Bands to the Detachment (at Naples or Salerno) on whose strength the Other Bands are borne. H.C. Commandant ACC (Main) and H.C. Commandant ACC (Port) will immediately such information and forward it, supported in the case of ACC Form B-3 by a nominal roll, to G-1 (British) at this H.C.

This does not apply to Internees and Displaced Persons Sub-Commission and to Italian Refugee Branch, which will continue to render returns and completion direct to this H.C.

2. Revised of Other Bands

It is the responsibility of Regional and Detachment Commanders to ensure that returns on displaced of British Other Bands both belonging and attached to ACC/ACC are reported to this H.C., with the date of arrival or departure, on ACC Form B-3.

3. Conclusion

(1) Verification that British Other Band is entitled to Trade Pay can be made from a study of his A.C. Part 1, in which a record of the Trade Pay which he has received is kept. Where there is any doubt as to his qualification to receive Trade Pay, this H.C. should be notified and verification will be made by this H.C. to G.O.P. and Echelon for confirmation.

(2) Vehicle Mechanism

Entry to the removal from the list of any number of British H.V. and Motor Mechanism - number of British O.P.'s is being requested as Vehicle Mechanism. British H.V. and Motor Mechanism who are not transferred as Vehicle Mechanism by 1 July 1944 will report to armed forces of pay.

This H.C. Letter reference 16092/9-1 dated 16 March 1944 refers.

4. O.P.'s who return to hospital whose return from hospital is required should be shown at Part 10 of ACC Form B-3. Their arrival at a Formation or Region after being discharged from hospital should be reported to this H.C. on ACC Form B-3.

Sub-Commissioners and members of A.C.C. Allied Central Commission will render returns on ACC Form R.3 and report immediately on ACC Form R.3 in respect of British Other Ranks to the Detachment (at Angkor or Salween) on whose strength the Other Ranks are borne. C.C. Despatch ACC (Main) and H.Q. Command ACC (Rear) will consolidate such information and forward it, supported in the case of ACC Form R.3 by a nominal roll, to H.Q. (British) at this H.Q.

There shall not be any suspension and Discharge Payments Sub-Commissioners and to Italian Induction Branch, which will continue to render returns and statistics direct to this H.Q.

2. Movement of Other Ranks

It is the responsibility of Regional and Detachment Commanders to ensure that arrivals and departures of British Other Ranks, both belonging and attached to A.C.C. are reported to this H.Q., with the date of arrival or departure, on ACC Form R.3.

3. Transfer

(1) Verification that - British Other Ranks is entitled to Trade Pay can be made from a copy of his A.C.C. Part 1, in which a record of the Trade Pay which he has earned is kept. Where there is any doubt as to his qualification to receive Trade Pay, this H.Q. should be notified and application will be made by this H.Q. to C.C. and Liaison for confirmation.

(11) Vehicle Mechanics

On the removal from the list of Army Branches of Pittsburg M.V. and Motor Mechanics - number of British C.E.'s are being transferred as Vehicle Mechanics. Pittsburg M.V. and Motor Mechanics who are not transferred as Vehicle Mechanics by 1 July '44 will revert to normal rates of pay.

This H.Q. letter reference 16012/2/-1 dated 25 March '44 refers.

4. C.E.'s entitled to hospital mode return from hospital is required should be shown at Part 'C' of ACC Form R.3. Their arrival at a formation or region after being discharged from hospital should be reported to this H.Q. on ACC Form R.3.

5. Classification of Pay

A copy of C.C. 41/4 is appended for the guidance of Officers concerned with the pay of Other Ranks. Attention is directed to para. 1 "Classification" which states that increases of pay in respect of upgrades to Class 1 and 2 are only granted to the holder when the C.C. Unit has authorized the grant by means of an appropriate notification. Such classifications should be reported to this H.Q. on ACC Form R.3.

3. Where there is any doubt as to whether an Other Rank holds an unpaid or paid appointment, the question should be referred to this HQ. This HQ will obtain the necessary information or authority from G.H.Q. 2nd London, S.W.L.P. or from No.8 Command Pay Office, C.E.S.

- The Army Council have drawn attention to the fact that accounts of personnel serving overseas reveal an increasing number of alarmingly large debtor balances. In a number of cases individual debts exceed £100.
- It would appear that certain officers serving overseas whose duty it is to make payments to soldiers show little or no regard for their personal responsibilities in regulating the amounts paid out to individuals.
- The attention of every officer will be drawn to his responsibility. In the absence of official knowledge of the state of a soldier's account, an officer has no authority to make a payment in excess of the net rate of pay shown in A.B.64, Part II. If he does so, he may be called upon to make good from his own pay, any resulting loss to the public.
- The Council desire to make it clear to all officers that write-off of a debt on a soldier's account does NOT preclude subsequent consideration of whether the officer or officers responsible for the over-payments should make good the loss of public funds.
- It is pointed out to the recipients of aggressive cash issues that the rates of pay shown in A.B.64, Part II are for the guidance of the soldier as well as the paying officer. A soldier who falls heavily into debt through counting cash payments, which on the evidence of his pay book are clearly excessive must not expect relief such as is given to soldiers who fall into debt through causes beyond their control.

SUBJECT: Payment of Enlisted Men.
