TO : All PCs, all special staff sections and RSU.

1. Letter this headquarters, subject courier service, dated 26 July 1944, is hereby rescinded.
2. Commencing this date, the courier will operate as indicated in paragraph 6 (Schedule). The courier will leave this headquarters every Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
3. A jeep or similar vehicle will be used for the service. Officers who wish to visit places en route may avail themselves of this vehicle but it must be understood that the mail takes priority and no deviation from the time table or route is permitted.
4. In lieu of the courier to Chieti, the British ration truck, which leaves this headquarters on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, will act as such. In addition to that run a vehicle will be dispatched each Sunday to Chieti and Ortona as a courier.
5. Since the truck for Chieti leaves at approximately 0700 hours, mail intended for it must be in the message center by 1530 hours the previous day. The truck will arrive in Chieti at approximately 1200 hours and will leave Chieti immediately after lunch.

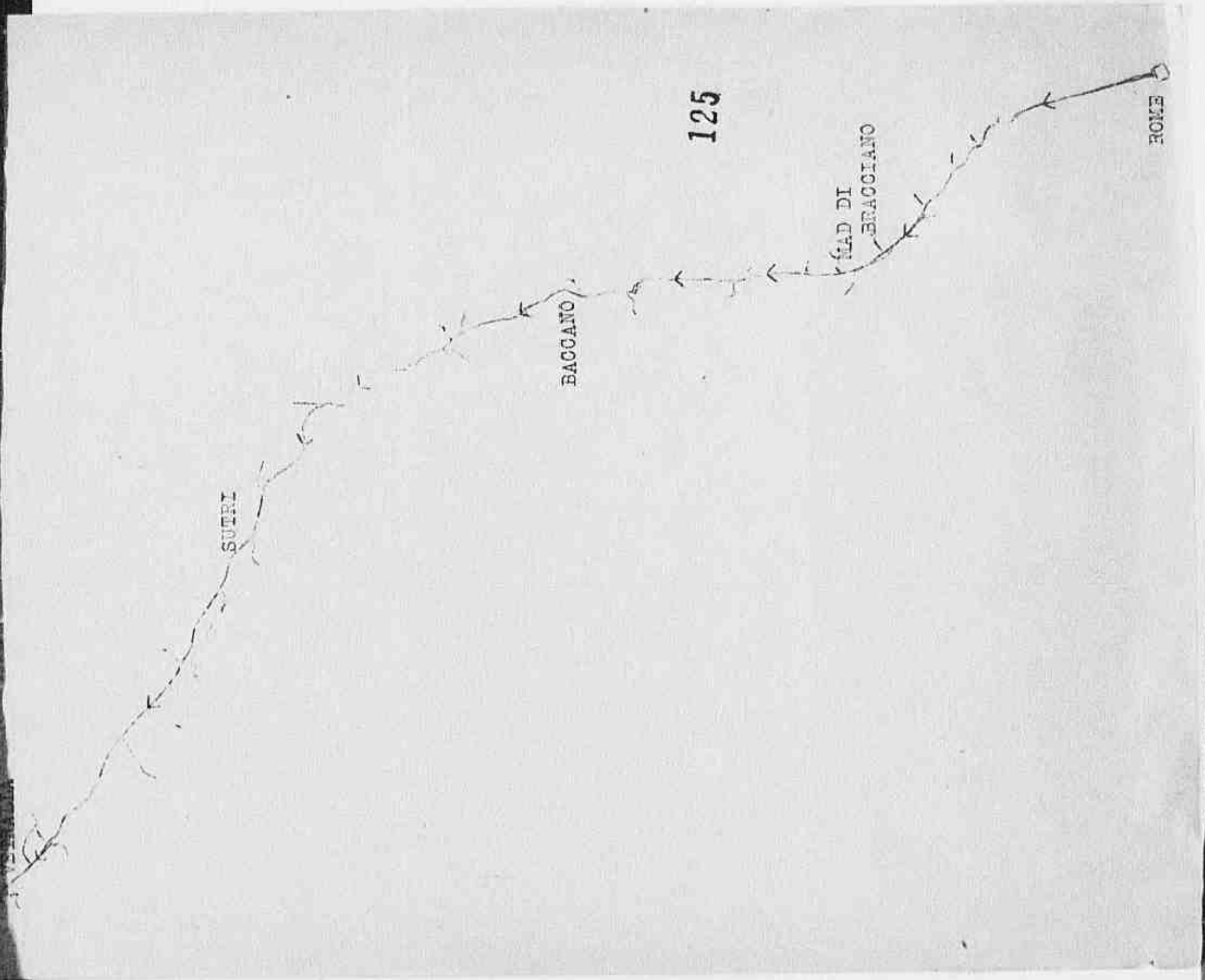

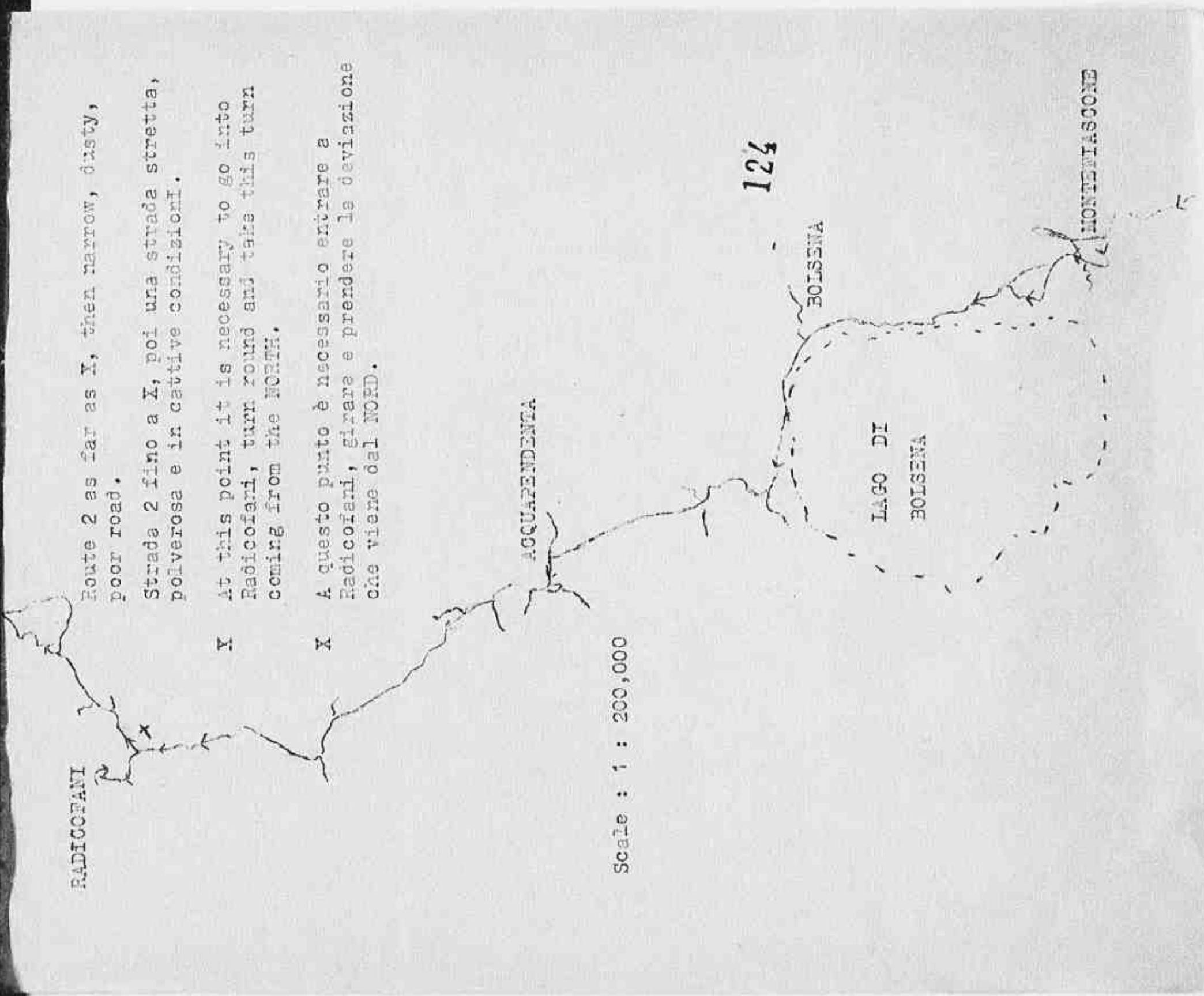

This courier service which will operate on alternate days and not daily as hitherto will be the normal means of tptn for officers and IM/OR's proceeding on official duty or leave to and from ROME, and, in future, it will be exceptional for individual tptn to be provided. The courier will not be authorized to accept any passengers for the outward journey to ROME without previous reservations which will be made through the M.T. Offr (Lieut ALLEN). Travel Orders will be obtained and carried in the normal way. The return journey will be made either on the same authority, or, in the case of visiting or newly joined personnel, by authority of Hq, ACC. If the demand for seats exceeds the supply available, the senior officer present will decide allotment. The courier will be in possession of specific orders re timings and under no circumstances will passengers attempt to vary these orders.

2. It is desired that the above information be brought to the attention of all concerned." (Aaj)

5. MARKING OF MINED AREAS.

All ranks will familiarise themselves with the signs used to denote uncleared minefields. They are as follows:-

(1) Marking.

1. Boundary Fence. When operational conditions permit each minefield will be enclosed by a wire fence consisting of a two wire cattle fence on the INNER side and a trip wire on the OUTER side. Tin triangles painted red or unpainted, of about 8" sides, will be hung on the two wire fences at about 50 yard intervals. The fence will NOT conform to the shape of the field. Trip wire marking minefields will be replaced by two wire cattle fences as soon as tactical considerations permit.

(2) Marking of Lanes. If the lanes in our own and enemy minefields have to be marked to enable men and vehicles to advance through, the following method will be used:-

By Day. Lanes will be marked by red and white boards (either rectangular or diamond in shape) so that the white sides flank the lane as shown in Figs. 1 & 2 below:

Reference above. I know of only two recent occasions when my DRs have been off-schedule at HQ AAI, which are explained as follows:

Firstly, my DR reported one night at 1700 hours instead of at 1800 hours the time agreed by Major Friend James and myself. This he did without my consent or knowledge. He has been reprimanded by me and I am confident we shall not have a recurrence.

Secondly by reason of sickness and trouble with MCs my strength of DRs was reduced to two. About 1130 hours an URGENT package was received for delivery and the DR who was to proceed to HQAAI was given same to deliver as the location of the addressee was in close proximity to HQ AAI. It took the DR longer to locate than was considered to be necessary and this caused his delay in reporting to HQ AAI.

SUBJECT: Dispatch Riders

TO : Executive Officers

1. In order to meet normal demands, it is absolutely essential that a minimum effective operating strength of four (4) dispatch riders be available to this department.
2. The number at present assigned for duty is five (5) but allowing for day off and maintenance the average effective strength is four.
3. On one morning recently however four of the DRs did not report for the following reasons:
 - a. DR day off
 - b. DR incapacitated by reason of accident
 - c. Motor cycle tire puncture - in workshops
 - d. Motor cycle clutch trouble - in workshops
4. Officer i/o British Motor Pool stated that there were no other DRs whom he could place temporarily at our disposal. Arising from this incident representation was made to G-1 (B) for six reinforcements with a view to the creation of a reserve but a reply has now been received that DR reinforcements are not available for posting at present from Base Depots.
5. In view of the above and with a view to the future it is submitted for consideration, that a departure be made from the normal transport procedure, whereby a driver must accompany his motor cycle into workshops, and that when a driver's motor cycle is in workshops, he be assigned one from the reserve pending repair of his own.
6. While fully appreciating the transport procedure I feel that in the circumstances the over-riding consideration should be the operations of this Headquarters in which uninterrupted execution of the DR services is highly desirable.

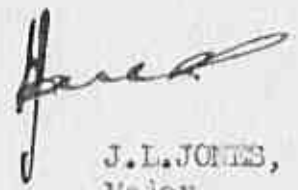

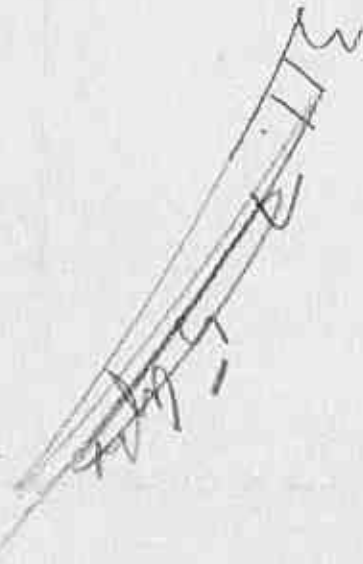

1. The present Naples - Salerno courier service is in the opinion of the undersigned not entirely satisfactory. The present arrangement is as follows: A courier leaves Naples twice daily at 0900 and 1500 hours.

2. It is impracticable for the Miscellaneous Section to handle and Message Center to prepare for transmission before 0900 all of the correspondence, radiograms, cables, etc., which have come in during the night in time to make the 0900 courier. This results in the following situation: A letter may arrive in this Headquarters during the night, fail to make the 0900 courier, be sent down on the 1500 courier, and thereby reach the office for which intended in Salerno over twenty-four (24) hours after reaching this Headquarters.

3. It is, therefore, recommended that the following changes be made:

a. The time of departure of the 0900 courier be changed to 0930.

b. An additional courier to leave at 1130.

c. The time of departure of the 1500 courier to be changed to 1600.

4. This would result in the following improvements in the communication in this and the Rear Headquarters:

a. Material received during the night would be in Salerno, at the latest, by the next afternoon early.

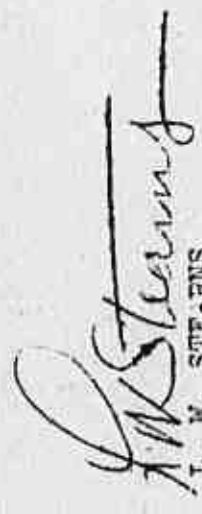
