Effective with the redesignation of the North African Theater of Operations, U.S. Army, as the Mediterranean Theater of Operations, U.S. Army, the boundaries of the Mediterranean Theater of Operations will be as follows: from 32° West longitude - 43° 45 minutes North latitude South along the 32° meridian West longitude to 13° 30 minutes North latitude, thence East along this parallel to the Western Coast of AFRICA, thence generally East and South along the French territorial boundaries in West AFRICA and along the Atlantic coast of AFRICA to the intersection of the western boundary of NIGERIA with the Gulf of Guinea, excluding GAMBIA, Portuguese GUINEA, SIERRA LEONE, LIBERIA and GOLD COAST, thence North and East along the boundary of NIGERIA to the intersection of the Nigerian French Equatorial African and French West African boundaries, thence Northward along the Eastern boundaries of French West Africa, ALGERIA and TUNISIA to the Mediterranean Coast, thence Northwesterly through the Mediterranean Sea to the intersection of the Southern border of TURKEY and Northern border of SYRIA with the Mediterranean Coast (i.e., including CYPRUS and all of the islands of the Aegean but excluding Cyprus); thence generally East and North along the Southern and Eastern political boundaries of TURKEY to the Black Sea, thence West and North through the Black Sea to the mouth of the Dniester River, thence generally North and West along the Northern political boundaries of ROMANIA, HUNGARY and AUSTRIA as they existed prior to 1939, to the boundary of SWITZERLAND, thence generally South and West along the Eastern and Southern boundaries of SWITZERLAND to the intersection with the Eastern boundary of FRANCE, thence South along the Eastern boundary of FRANCE to the intersection of the FRENCH-ITALIAN border and the Mediterranean Sea, thence generally West and Northwest along the waters adjacent to the Southern coast of FRANCE to the intersection of the SPANISH-FRENCH border and the Mediterranean Sea, thence West along the Southern boundary of FRANCE to the intersection of the SPANISH-FRENCH border at the Bay of Biscay, thence generally West along the Northern Spanish Coast to 43° 45 minutes North latitude, thence West to the point of beginning.

SUBJECT: Removal of Allied Garrison from Sardinia.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Control Commission

Reference your 323.3-6/Ex.O of 6 September.

1. It is true that after the Garrison is completely closed there will be no means of electrical communications to the Island other than the submarine cable facilities which will be operated under Italian control.

2. However, we are informed by Signal Section of this Headquarters that a set of one-time pad ciphers will be furnished to your offices in Rome and Sardinia which will permit completely secure communications over the Italian Cable facilities and should eliminate any necessity for Air Courier service.

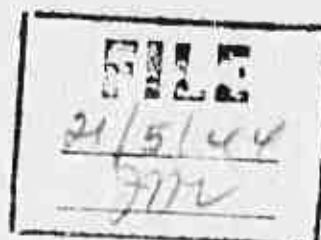

1. Effective at 0001B hours 17 July 1944, the Caserta area, boundaries shown below, is designated as an exempted area under the direct control of Allied Force Headquarters.

Map reference: Sheet 172, Caserta, 1 : 100,000

Boundaries : CAPUA (incl) - generally EAST along NORTH bank of VOLTURNIA River to creek junction 2000 yards EAST of LINATOLA - SOUTHEAST to PONTE BIFERCHIA (incl) - SOUTH SOUTHWEST along highway (incl) to MADDALONI (incl) - SOUTH SOUTHEAST along railroad (incl) to crossroads at 34.9 - 63.8 - WEST SOUTHWEST along highway (incl) to CAIVANO (excl) - NORTH along main NAPLES - CASERTA highway (incl) to SOUTH bank of REGI LACINI Canal - WEST NORTHWEST along SOUTH bank of canal to North South grid 10 thence NORTH to VOLTURNIA River - EAST along NORTH bank of VOLTURNIA to CAPUA.

2. The Commanding Officer, Headquarters Command Allied Force, is announced as area commander of the above area, and as such is charged with general area administration, protection, security, and coordination of allied activities within the area under announced policies or directives of this headquarters.

3. Peninsular Base Section and No 3 District will be the supporting supply agencies for the area and the Commanding Officer, Headquarters Command Allied Force, is authorized to deal directly with the Commanding General, Peninsular Base Section, and General Officer Commanding No 3 District in matters of supply of American and British units or personnel of Allied Force Headquarters and North African Theater of Operations, United States Army.

River BIFFERNO from its mouth to BOLANO (H.3920); thence a straight line to PIEDIMONTE D'ALIFE (H.3106); thence road to PONTE UMBERTO MARINIERA (H.2796), thence the line of River VOLTURNO to its mouth.

2. Para.4(g) of 316/76/CA of 26 April 1944 is amended to read:

" The movement of members of the Italian Military Forces is only unrestricted providing they are on duty, in possession of proper credentials, and subject to certain regulations which have been laid down by the Allied Military authorities (with which the Italian Military authorities are conversant).

The Italian Military Forces when not on duty, e.g. when on leave, are subject to the same restrictions as civilians. "

 Rear - From the sea at N 2647 - inclusive canal to N 2750, thence to N 2552 - inclusive U.S. Traffic Route 'H' to N 2452 - inclusive road NAPLES - CASERTA as far as N 2767 - exclusive CANCELLO (N 3565) - exclusive road CANCELLO - BENEVENTO (N 6481) - PESCOLANAZZA (N 6892) as far as its junction with inter-army boundary near PESCOLANAZZA.

2. a. No. 2 District will include the regions of CALABRIA, LUCANIA, APULIA, and that portion of the region of CAMPANIA which is not designated as part of the Peninsular Base Section area in Par. 1 above.
