SUBJECT: Violations of NATOUSA Administrative Instructions.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Repeated instructions concerning the return of prisoners of war to inclosures prior to a unit's change of location have in the past been ignored by certain organizations of this command.

2. Paragraph 10, Administrative Instructions for United States Army Control of Italian Service Units, NATOUSA, file AG 336.2/293 A-0, dated 5 January 1944, is quoted in part:

"No Italian service units will be moved within the base section except on orders of the base section commander and will not be moved from one base section to another base section except as ordered by this headquarters. No Italian service units or individual Italian personnel or prisoner of war will be moved outside of North Africa without authority of this headquarters."

3. To prevent future violations of this nature, it is desired that the above quoted instructions be brought to the attention of all concerned.
