1. Reference is made to War Department letter, File AG 400 (12 June 44) OF-S-SPOM-M, subject: "Supply of Newly Standardized Items to Overseas Commands", dated 14 June 1944.

2. Goggles, M-1944 are equipped with interchangeable green lens and clear lens, which can be utilized for all purposes as required by personnel of organizations to which they are authorized. This item was standardized in lieu of Goggles, M-1943, with green lens; Goggles, M-1943, with clear lens; and Goggles, M-1943 with red lens.

3. The provisions of Section II, War Department Circular 417, dated 25 October 1944, will govern the issue of the newly standardized Goggles, M-1944, Table of Equipment authorizations notwithstanding. This is quoted for ready reference:

VII-GOGGLES - The following instructions will govern supply of the newly standardized goggles, M-1944:

1. The following goggles, which are limited standard and no longer available, will be retained by using troops until worn out:

- Goggles, M-1943
- Goggles, M-1943
- Goggles, plastic lens: clear: green tint
- Goggles, M-1943

2. The newly standardized goggles, M-1944, will replace the above goggles only so far as the following basis of issue authorizes such replacement:

a. One per individual in armored, tank destroyer, and mechanized cavalry units.

b. One per individual regularly assigned to a track-laying vehicle, other than armored, tank destroyer, and mechanized cavalry units.

c. Two per fuel-consuming motor vehicle, except motorcycle not provided for by a and b above.

d. One per crew member of armored car not otherwise provided for.

e. One per lineman: photographer; Enlisted Men in traffic squad, column CA, T/O & E 19-500; traffic section T/O & E 19-7; traffic platoon T/O & E 19-37.

f. One per caliber 50 machine gun in military police units.

g. One per motorcycle.

3. An exception to paragraph 1 and 2 will be made in the case of armored, tank destroyer, mechanized cavalry, and quartermaster truck units. Goggles, M-1944, will be issued immediately upon availability to these units in active overseas theaters in accordance with the basis of issue in paragraph 2 and limited standard goggles will be turned in. These limited standard goggles turned in will be reissued to units other than armored, tank destroyer, mechanized cavalry, and quartermaster truck units, in accordance with the basis of issue cited in paragraph 2, prior to issue of goggles, M-1944.

4. Priority of replacement of limited standard goggles with goggles, M-1944, on the basis of issue cited in paragraph 2 will be as follows:

- 1st Priority - Armored, tank destroyer, mechanized cavalry, and quartermaster truck units in active theaters.
- 2d Priority - All other units in active theaters.

5. Under no circumstances will more than one pair of goggles be issued per individual authorized such issue."

4. Paragraph 3, of above quoted War Department Circular, will be held in strict compliance.

5. Replacement factor is 8.34 per month of initial issue. Goggles, M-1944 will be available on or about 15 January 1945.

6. It is requested that each base section and separate depot forward total initial issue requirements to this headquarters as soon as ascertained. Initial issue is only for those troops listed in 1st priority, paragraph 4, Section II, War Department Circular 417, quoted above. Negative reports will be submitted if applicable.

S-3239: 124-125-12: Teletypewriter Set 12-12.

TO: AF 124-125-12.

1. The situation for Teletypewriter Set 12-12 has become critical, due to requirements, in excess of 100,000 requirements.

2. It is necessary therefore that all teletypewriter sets 12-12 which are obsolete, or are replaced by other type of equipment be returned to depot stocks for future use.

3. All teletypewriter sets 12-12, or operating teletypewriter sets 12-12, which are obsolete, or are replaced by other type of equipment, shall be returned to depot stocks for future use.

4. The sets 12-12 or sets 12-12 that can be immediately replaced, shall be returned to APO SAN for depot stocks without delay.

5. The sets 12-12 that can be replaced through substitution of other teletypewriter equipment, and the quantity and kind of equipment needed.

6. The sets 12-12 that can be replaced through substitution of other teletypewriter equipment, shall be returned to APO SAN for depot stocks without delay.
